1. The following property is hereby designated as an historical property:

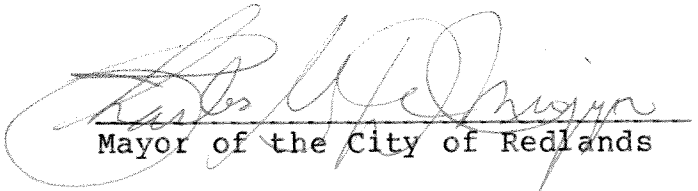
