WHEREAS, the Historic and Scenic Preservation Commission has held a duly advertised public hearing to consider designating the following as a historical property:

WHEREAS, the Historic and Scenic Preservation Commission has nominated the above-mentioned property as a historic property in accordance with procedures established in Chapter 2.62 of the Redlands Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redlands has held a duly advertised public hearing to consider the recommendation of the Historic and Scenic Preservation Commission; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Redlands as follows:

The following property is hereby designated as a historical property:

House of Neighborly Service 612 Lawton Street Redlands, California 92374

2. This historic property shall not be altered on the exterior, moved, demolished, subdivided, or other wise permanently changed on the exterior until a Certificate of Appropriateness has been secured.

- The City Clerk of the City of Redlands is hereby 4. directed to cause a certified copy of this Resolution to be recorded with the County Recorder, County of San Bernardino.

HOUSE OF NEIGHBORLY SERVICE
