

RESOLUTION NO. 2160

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS SPECIFYING THE HOURLY WAGE RATES AND BENEFITS FOR VARIOUS BUILDING TRADE CLASSIFICATIONS.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED:

SECTION ONE: THAT this resolution rescinds resolution 2172, a resolution specifying the hourly wage rates and benefits for the various building trade classifications, for the year of October 1, 1960 - September 30, 1961.

SECTION TWO: THAT the City of Redlands, a body awarding contracts for public works, hereby determines the general prevailing per diem wages for classifications or types of building trade workmen needed to execute contracts for public works projects of said city during 1962.

SECTION THREE: THAT the hourly wage rates for the classifications shown herein are "prevailing wages" for the locality of Redlands.

SECTION FOUR: THAT said hourly wage rates include employer payments for health and welfare, pension, vacation and other payments considered a part of wages.

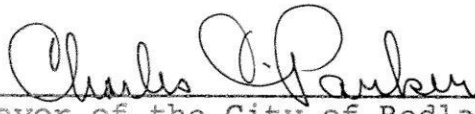
SECTION FIVE: THAT the public works classifications and "prevailing wages" for them as determined by this City Council are as follows:

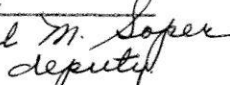
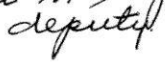
