## RESOLUTION NO. 3458

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS ESTABLISHING A SALARY SCHEDULE AND COMPENSATION PLAN FOR CITY EMPLOYEES AND RESCINDING RESOLUTIONS NO. 3377, 3396, 3418, 3427, 3430 AND 3441
