

RESOLUTION NO. 4182

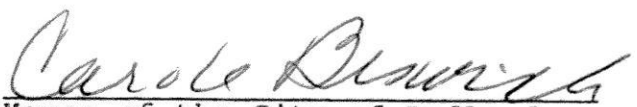

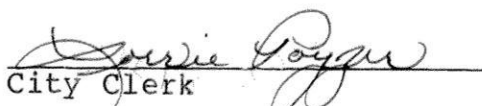
