

RESOLUTION NO. 2743

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS
RELATIVE TO PRICING POLICY DETERMINATION TO BE MADE BY
THE SAN BERNARDINO MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Liaison Pricing Committee has requested the SBVMWD to engage an economic consultant to undertake a study to show the effect of various methods by which the District may receive revenue to pay its proportionate share of the costs of the California Water Plan, and

WHEREAS, the District has engaged the firm of Bartle-Wells to undertake this study and this study is presently underway, and

WHEREAS, it is assumed the District will use this study to assist it in formulating its basic policy regarding methods of collecting the necessary revenue to conduct its basic function of providing supplemental water to the area, and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of harmony throughout the District that the viewpoint of all major constituent agencies be taken into account in the determination of the final policy to be adopted by the District, and

WHEREAS, the City of Redlands represents a substantial share of the assessed valuation of the District and will therefore be paying a proportionately substantial amount of moneys to the District through any ad valorem taxes levied by the District,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Redlands does hereby request the Board of Directors of the SBVMWD to refrain from establishing a policy on general pricing of supplemental water until it has distributed the aforementioned economic study in its final form to all major constituent agencies and interested parties and a reasonable period of time thereafter scheduled public hearings to receive the official positions and opinions of its constituents.
