The construction of a six (6) Inch vitrified pipe sewer on Eleventh street beginning at a point two hundred and twenty-two (222) feet north of the north line of Central Avenue.

Together with, and as part of said sewer, one (1) manhole and seven (7) four (4) inch vitrified pipe Y's or Y-branch laterals, to be connected with such sewer, and extending to the curb lines on each side thereof.

All of such manholes and Y-branch laterals to be of such sizes and dimensions and to be placed where and as shown on the plans and specifications therefor.
