

Sewer - portion Clay Street

NOTICE INVITING SEALED PROPOSALS

(Sewer, Portion Clay St.)

Pursuant to statute and resolution of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, adopted on the 2nd day of April, 1924, directing this notice, the undersigned invites and will receive at his office, in said City, up to two o'clock p. m. on the 16th day of April, 1924, sealed proposals or bids, for the following street work, to be done according to specifications therefor, posted and on file, adopted for said work, as herein mentioned, to-wit:

The construction of an eight inch vitrified public sewer upon Clay street in said city as follows: Beginning at and connecting with a sewer upon said street at a point about 330 feet south of Lugonia Avenue and extending thence to Delaware Avenue in said city, together with and as a part of said sewer two manholes and thirty eight inch by four inch vitrified pipe Ys or Y branch laterals to be connected with said sewer pipe. Such manholes and Y or Y branch laterals to be of such sizes and dimensions and to be placed where and as shown on the plans and specifications therefor. All said sewer, sewer pipes, manholes, Ys or Y branch laterals and all work connected therewith and material therefor, shall be constructed as provided by and in accordance with the specifications, plans and profiles therefor on file in the office of the city engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

Reference is hereby made to Resolution of Intention No. 359 of said Board declaring its intention to order said work to be done for further particulars, which resolution is on file in my office.

Bidders must file with each proposal or bid, a check payable to said City, certified by a responsible bank, for an amount which shall not be less than ten per cent of the aggregate of the proposal, or a bond for the said amount and so payable, signed by the bidder and two sureties, who shall justify before any officer competent to administer an oath, in double the said amount, and over and above all statutory exemptions.

Bids will be opened on the 16th day of April, 1924, at 2 o'clock p. m., and if a contract for said work be not then awarded, further bids will be received at any subsequent meeting of said Board until a contract therefor shall be awarded.

(Item 2, Sewer, portion of Clay St.)

Pursuant to the resolution of award of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, adopted on the 16th day of April, 1924, directing this notice, notice is hereby given that the said Board of Trustees, in open session, on said date, opened, examined and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the following street work, to-wit:

The construction of an eight inch vitrified public sewer upon Clay street in said city as follows: Beginning at and connecting with a sewer upon said street at a point about 330 feet south of Lugonia Avenue and extending thence to Delaware Avenue in said city, together with and as a part of said sewer two manholes and thirty eight inch by four inch vitrified pipe Ys or Y branch laterals to be connected with said sewer pipe. Such manholes and Y or Y branch laterals to be of such sizes and dimensions and to be placed where and as shown on the plans and specifications therefor. All said sewer, sewer pipes, manholes, Ys or Y branch laterals and all work connected therewith and material therefor, shall be constructed as provided by and in accordance with the specifications, plans and profiles therefor on file in the office of the city engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

And thereafter, to-wit, on the 16th day of April, 1924, awarded the contract for said work to the lowest regular responsible bidder, to-wit: H. H. Lienau at the prices named for said work in his proposal on file, to-wit: Seventy-six cents per lineal foot for said sewer and \$100 for each of said manholes.

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION

No. 359

(Concrete Gutter on Citrus Ave.;
Sewer on Clay St.)

Resolved, That the public interest and convenience require, and that it is the intention of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands to order the following street work to be done, and improvement to be made, to-wit:

Item 1st. The construction of cement concrete gutters upon both sides of East Citrus Avenue from the east curb line of Sixth street to the west curb line of Church street, except where shown on the plans of said work hereinafter referred to.

Item 2nd. The construction of an eight inch vitrified public sewer upon Clay street in said city as follows: Beginning at and connecting with a sewer upon said street at a point about 330 feet south of Lugonia Avenue and extending thence to Delaware Avenue in said city, together with and as a part of said sewer two manholes and thirty eight inch by four inch vitrified pipe Ys or Y branch laterals to be connected with said sewer pipe. Such manholes and Y or Y branch laterals to be of such sizes and dimensions and to be placed where and as shown on the plans and specifications therefor. All said sewer, sewer pipes, manholes, Ys or Y branch laterals and all work connected therewith and material therefor, shall be constructed as provided by and in accordance with the specifications, plans and profiles therefor on file in the office of the city engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

All of said gutter shall be done in accordance with the plans, specifications, profiles and cross-sections therefor, heretofore adopted for doing said work, and now on file in the office of the City Engineer of said City, to all of which reference is hereby made.
