

Sewer - East Central Avenue

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION

Has. 28
Sewer Construction on East Central Avenue.

Resolved, That the public health and convenience require, and it is the intention of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands to order the following street work to be done, to wit:

The construction of an eight inch vitrified pipe sewer upon East Central Avenue in said City of Redlands, extending from and connecting with the present sewer on said Avenue at a point in said Avenue distant forty feet west from a point in said Avenue south of the west line of lot 28 Block H of Lagonia Park in said city and thence extending east on said Avenue 72 feet, together with and as a part of said sewer one manhole and 18 eight inch by four inch vitrified pipe Ys or Y branch laterals to be connected with said sewer pipe.

All of such manhole and Ys or Y branch laterals to be of such sizes and dimensions and to be placed where and as shown on the plans and specifications therefor. All said sewer, sewer pipes, manholes, Ys or Y branch laterals and all work connected therewith and material therefor, shall be constructed as shall be provided by and in accordance with the specifications, plans and profiles therefor on file in the office of the city engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

That the work of constructing said sewer is in the opinion of said Board of more than local and ordinary public benefit, and that the expense of said work is hereby made chargeable upon the district hereinafter specified; that the exterior boundaries of said district established and the exterior boundaries of the lands hereby declared to be benefited by said work and improvement and to be assessed to pay the costs and expenses there- of are described as follows:

Said district is situated within the City of Redlands, San Bernardino County, State of California, and particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the southwest corner of lot one of Block "L" of Lagonia Park in said city according to a map thereof of record in the office of the county recorder of county and thence in an easterly direction along the south lines of said block to the south- east corner of lot 8 in said block, thence north to the northeast corner of lot 21 in Block "H" of said Lagonia Park, thence west to the north- west corner of lot 28 of said Block "H" thence south to the place of beginning, saving and excepting there- from all public streets.

It is hereby determined, in pursu- ance of an Act of the Legislature of the State of California known as Im- provement Act of 1911, approved April 7th, 1911, that serial bonds shall be issued to represent assessment of \$25.00 or over for the cost of said work or improvement. Said bonds shall be ser- ial extending over a period of nine years from the second day of January next succeeding their date, and an even annual proportion of the prin- cipal sum thereof shall be payable by coupon on the second day of Jan- uary of each year after their date, until the whole is paid and the in- terest shall be payable semi-annual- ly by coupon on the second days of January and July, respectively of each year at the rate of seven per cent per annum on all sums unpaid until the whole of said principal and in- terest are paid. Said bonds shall be issued in form as required by said Act.

The 5th day of October, 1921, at two o'clock P. M. at the council chamber of said board is hereby fixed as the time and place when and where any and all persons having any ob- jections to the said proposed work or improvement may appear before said Board and show cause why said pro- posed improvement should not be car- ried out in accordance with this reso- lution.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this resolution for two days in the Redlands Daily Facts a daily newspaper published and circulated in said city, hereby designated for that purpose.

The Superintendent of Streets of said city is hereby directed to post notice of the passage of this resolu- tion in the manner and in the form and as required by law.

I hereby certify that the foregoing resolution was passed by said Board of Trustees on September 7, 1921, at a regular meeting thereof, by the fol- lowing vote:
