

E. Central Ave Sewer and Beacon St sidewalks.

Notice Inviting Sealed Proposals No. 379.

(Sewer East Central Ave.; Sidewalks Beacon St.)

Pursuant to Statute and to Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, directing this notice, said Board hereby invites sealed proposals or bids for doing the following work in said City, to-wit:

Item 1. That an eight inch vitrified pipe sewer be constructed on Central Avenue in said city from and connecting with the existing sewer on Central Avenue west of University Street to a point two hundred and thirty-five (235) feet east of the center line of Grove Street, together with and as a part of said sewer fifty-four eight inch by four inch Ys and four manholes to be connected with said eight inch sewer pipe.

Item 2. That a cement sidewalk five feet in width be constructed on the easterly side of Beacon Street in said city between Citrus Avenue and Fern Avenue where not already constructed.

All of said work mentioned in each of said two items shall be done and improvements made upon the grades, along the lines, between the points, of the dimensions, at the places and in the manner and as shown upon and according to the plans, profiles and detail drawings for each of said respective items of work, and according to the specifications therefor, which said plans, profiles, detail drawings and specifications have heretofore been adopted by said board for doing said work, and are now on file in the office of the city engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

Each of said two items of work shall be deemed separate and distinct from each other and as a separate item of work for which separate bids shall be received and separate contracts made therefor.

Said contemplated work and improvement, as to each of said respective items of work, is, in the opinion of said Board, of more than local or ordinary public benefit; and therefore the expense of each such item of said work and improvement is hereby made chargeable upon the respective districts hereinafter specified; that the exterior boundaries of each of said respective districts hereby established and declared to be benefited by each such item of work and improvement, and to be assessed to pay the cost and expenses thereof, is indicated and shown by a brown boundary line surrounding each such district and lands declared benefited by each such item of work, which line shows and indicates the exterior boundaries and extent of the territory included in each such district, upon a separate plat showing the lands embraced within each such district and being marked "Assessment District" (being the assessment district for each of said respective items of said work aforesaid,) and being on file in the office of said City Engineer, to which respective assessment district reference is hereby made.

The said Board of Trustees also determines and declares that serial bonds bearing interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum shall be issued to represent each assessment of \$25.00 or more remaining unpaid for twenty days after the date of the warrant as to each of said respective item of work.

Said serial bonds shall extend over a period of nine years from the second day of January next succeeding the 15th day of November following their date. Payments on the principal of unpaid assessments and interest shall be made by property owners to the City Treasurer and the same shall be disbursed by him, all as provided in and by the Improvement Act of 1911, so-called. The principal and interest of said bonds shall be payable in the manner and as provided by said Act.

Reference is hereby made to Resolution of Intention No. 379 of said City, declaring its intention to order said work to be done, for further particulars, which Resolution is on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City, and reference is hereby further made to the specifications for said work posted and on file.

All proposals or bids shall be accompanied by a check payable to the City of Redlands, certified by a responsible bank for an amount which shall not be less than ten per cent of the aggregate of the proposal, or by a bond for the said amount and so payable, signed by the bidder and two sureties, who shall justify, before any officer competent to administer an oath, in double the said amount, and over and above all statutory exemptions. Said proposals or bids shall be delivered to the Clerk of said City, on or before the 21st day of April, 1925, at 2 p.m.

(East Central Avenue.) Pursuant to Statute and to the Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, directing this notice, said Board hereby invites sealed proposals or bids for doing the following work in said City, to-wit:

Item 1. That an eight inch vitrified pipe sewer be constructed on Central Avenue in said city from and connecting with the existing sewer on Central Avenue west of University Street to a point two hundred and thirty-five (235) feet east of the center line of Grove Street, together with and as a part of said sewer fifty-four eight inch by four inch Ys and four manholes to be connected with said eight inch sewer pipe.

Item 2. That a cement sidewalk five feet in width be constructed on the easterly side of Beacon Street in said city between Citrus Avenue and Fern Avenue where not already constructed.

Resolved, That the public interest and convenience require, and that it is the intention of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands to order the following work to be done, and improvement to be made, to-wit:

Item 1. That an eight inch vitrified pipe sewer be constructed on Central Avenue in said city from and connecting with the existing sewer on Central Avenue west of University Street to a point two hundred and thirty-five (235) feet east of the center line of Grove Street, together with and as a part of said sewer fifty-four eight inch by four inch Ys and four manholes to be connected with said eight inch sewer pipe.

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The said Board of Trustees also determines and declares that serial bonds bearing interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum shall be issued to represent each assessment of \$25.00 or more remaining unpaid for twenty days after the date of the warrant as to each of said respective item of work.
