Notice Inviting Sealed Proposals No. 298

Pursuant to statute and the resolution of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, adopted on the 20th day of March, 1912, directing this notice, the undersigned invites and will receive at his office in said city, up to two o'clock p. m. on the third day of April, 1912, sealed proposals or bids, for the following street work, to be done according to specifications therefor, posted and on file, adopted for said work, or herein mentioned, to-wit:

(a) The construction of a stone and cement storm water ditch, or drain, on the northerly side of Marian avenue beginning at the east end of a culvert on Marian avenue distant about eighty-five (85) feet south of the south line of Fifth avenue; thence extending to the intersection of Marian avenue with the easterly curb line of Daisy avenue, and the construction of twenty-two (22) concrete posts along the southerly side of said ditch, or drain, with an iron coil chain connecting each of such posts.

(b) The construction of stone curbs and concrete gutters on the easterly side of Daisy avenue beginning at and connecting with the easterly end of the said storm water ditch, or drain, thence extending to and connecting with a culvert on Daisy avenue distant southerly about four hundred and thirteen (413) feet. Also beginning at and connecting with the westerly end of said culvert on Marian avenue, above referred to, and then extending along the southerly side of Marian avenue to Daisy avenue and thence on the westerly side of Daisy avenue a distance of about four hundred and thirty-three (433) feet.

All of said work described in paragraphs (a) and (b) above to be placed where and as shown on the plans therefor, and all to be done according to said plans, profiles and cross-sections and specifications therefor all on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

That said work and improvement is, in the opinion of the said Board of more than local and ordinary public benefit, and the expense of said work and improvement is, therefore, hereby made chargeable upon the district hereinafter specified.

That the exterior boundaries of said district hereby established and the exterior boundaries of the lands hereby declared to be benefitted by said work and improvement and to be assessed to pay the costs and expenses thereof, and to be known as the Assessment District are described as follows:

Commencing on Fifth avenue at the northeast corner of lot 2, Crafts' map of East Redlands, thence south along the east line of said lot 2 to the northeast corner of lot 4, said Crafts' Map;

Pursuant to the resolution of award of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands adopted on the 3d day of April, 1912, directing this notice, notice is hereby given that the said Board of Trustees, in open session, on said date, opened, examined and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the following street work, to-wit:

(a) The construction of a stone and cement storm water ditch, or drain, on the northerly side of Marian avenue beginning at the east end of a culvert on Marian avenue distant about eighty-five (85) feet south of the south line of Fifth avenue; thence extending to the intersection of Marian avenue with the easterly curb line of Daisy avenue, and the construction of twenty-two (22) concrete posts along the southerly side of said ditch, or drain, with an iron coil chain connecting each of such posts.

Commencing on Fifth avenue at the northeast corner of lot 2, Crafts' map of East Redlands, thence south along the east line of said lot 2 to the northeast corner of lot 4, said Crafts' Map; thence southerly to the most easterly corner of said lot 4; thence westerly along the southerly line of Lots 4 and 5, said Crafts' Map to Yucaipa avenue; thence northerly along said Yucaipa avenue to Fifth avenue; thence easterly along said Fifth avenue to the point of beginning.

And thereafter, to-wit, on the 3d day of April, 1912, awarded the contract for said work to the lowest regular responsible bidder, to-wit, F. Montigel & Son, at the prices named for said work in their proposal on file, to-wit:

For 10-inch curbs and 2.5-inch gutters, per lineal foot.....	\$.44
For curbs over 10-inch, per cubic foot	.27½
For 5-foot gutter, per lineal foot	.69
For storm ditch, per lineal foot complete	1.18
For posts set complete, with chain complete	132.00

thence southerly to the most easterly corner of said lot 4; thence westerly along the southerly line of Lots 4 and 5, said Crafts' Map to Yucaipa avenue; thence northerly along said Yucaipa avenue to Fifth avenue; thence easterly along said Fifth avenue to the point of beginning.

Bidders must file with each proposal or bid, a check payable to the order of the President of the Board of Trustees of said city, certified by a responsible bank, for an amount which shall not be less than ten per cent of the aggregate of the proposal, or a bond for the said amount and so payable, signed by the bidder and two sureties, who shall justify before any officer competent to administer an oath, in double the said amount, and over and above all statutory exemptions.
