

Resolution of Intention
No. 490

(Bellevue Road Improvement)
RESOLVED, That the public interest and convenience require, and that it is the intention of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands to order the following work to be done, and improvement to be made, to-wit:

That the roadway of Bellevue Road in said city from the east curb line of Terracina Boulevard, produced across said Bellevue Road, to the south curb line of West Fern Avenue, produced across said Bellevue Road, including the roadway of all street intersections between said points, be graded, oiled and surfaced; also the construction of concrete curbs and gutters on both sides of Bellevue Road between said points, where not already constructed; also the construction of concrete dip gutter crossings at all private driveways and alleyways as shown on the plans; also the construction of 2 corrugated iron culverts across Bellevue Road as shown on plans.

Said contemplated work and improvement is, in the opinion of said Board, of more than local or ordinary public benefit and the expense of said work and improvement is hereby made chargeable upon the district hereinafter specified; that the exterior boundaries of said district hereby declared to be benefited by said work and improvement and to be assessed to pay the costs and expenses thereof are described as follows: Commencing at the southwesterly corner of Lot 38 West Fern Heights, Tract No. 2016, Book 29 of Maps, page 73, San Bernardino County Records, California, thence easterly to the southeasterly corner of said Lot 38; thence southerly and easterly along the alleyway in said West Fern Heights to the southwesterly corner of Lot 51 of said West Fern Heights; thence to the southeasterly corner of said West Fern Heights; thence South 11 degrees 2 minutes East 26.73 feet; thence north 55 degrees 20 minutes East to the westerly line of Sunnyside Avenue; thence northerly along the westerly line of Sunnyside Avenue to the southerly line of West Fern Avenue; thence westerly along the southerly line of West Fern Avenue to the northwesterly corner of Lot 18 of said West Fern Heights; thence southerly to the southwesterly corner of said Lot 18; thence westerly and southerly along the alleyway in said West Fern Heights to the northwesterly corner of Lot 37 of said West Fern Heights; thence westerly to the northwesterly corner of said Lot 37; thence southerly to the point of beginning.

All of said work mentioned shall be done and improvement made upon the grade, along the lines, between the points, of the dimensions, at the place and in the manner and as shown upon and according to the plans, profiles and detail drawings for said work and according to the specifications, hereof, which said plans, profiles, detail drawings and specifications have heretofore been adopted by said Board for doing said work and are now on file in the office of the city engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

The said Board of Trustees also determines and declares that serial bonds bearing interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum shall be issued to represent each assessment of \$25.00 or more remaining unpaid for thirty days after the date of the warrant as to said work.

Said serial bonds shall extend over a period of nine years from the second day of January next succeeding the 15th day of the Next November following their date.

Payments on the principal of unpaid assessments and interest shall be made by property owners to the City Treasurer and the same shall be disbursed by him, all as provided in and by the Improvement Act of 1911, so-called. The principal and interest of said bonds shall be payable in the manner and as provided by said Act.

Notice is hereby given that, on the 7th day of August, 1929, at 2 o'clock p.m., in the Council Chamber of said Board, any and all persons having any objections to the proposed work or improvement may appear before said Board, and show cause why said work or improvement should not be carried out in accordance with this resolution.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this resolution twice in the manner required by law, in the Redlands Daily Facts, a daily newspaper published and circulated in said city, hereby designated for that purpose.

The Superintendent of Streets of said city is hereby directed to post notices of the passage of this resolution in the time, form, manner and as required by the said "Im-
