

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO.215.

Resolved that the public interest and convenience require and that it is the intention of the board of trustees of the city of Redlands to order the following street work to be done, to wit:-

1st. That Cajon street, from the south line of the roadway of West Citrus Avenue to the southerly line of Olive Avenue, be improved by having the following street work done thereon, to wit: (a) That the roadway of said Cajon street, between said points,

including all intersections of streets (excepting such portions of Cajon street, and intersections as are required by law to be kept in order or repair by any person or company having railroad tracks thereon, and such portions thereof as have already been paved, and such portions thereof now occupied by four wooden culverts, one at East Vine street, one at East Olive avenue, and one at West Olive avenue, entrances, and one at east side of Cajon street, extending from West Citrus avenue, to present paving on Cajon street, and also excepting 27 inches in width from the curb lines on each side of said Cajon street, along the gutter way thereof, where cobble stone gutters have been laid) shall be paved with asphaltic cement and broken stone base, with asphalt wearing surface, in accordance with plans, profile and cross-sections therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Clerk, *to all of which reference is hereby made; and*

*(b) That one culvert be constructed along the westerly gutter line of said Cajon street, extending across the entrance into West Vine street. Said culvert to be 33 inches wide and 12 inches high, inside measurement, and to be constructed of concrete with steel plate top, and all in accordance with plans therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer, and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Clerk, to all of which reference is hereby made; and*

*(c) That all cobble stone gutters along each side of said Cajon street to be paved as aforesaid, for a width of 27 inches from the curb lines of said street (excepting along said culverts, and also excepting where already grouted or surfaced with cement, in accordance with plans therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Clerk, to all of which reference is hereby made; and*

*(d) That three walls to be constructed of concrete to be located as follows: one at East Vine St. Culvert; one at East and one at West Olive avenue culverts. Each to be 12 inches deep by 7 inches wide, and the full length of such culverts, and to be in accordance with plans for the same on file in the engineer's office, and specifications therefor on file in the City Clerk's office, to all of which reference is hereby made.*

2nd. That the roadway of East Citrus Avenue, from the north line of said street to the east curb line of Fifth Street, be improved by having the following street work done thereon, to wit: (a) That the roadway of said East Citrus Avenue, from the north line of said street to the east curb line of Fifth Street, including all intersections of streets (excepting such portions of said street and intersections as are required by law to be kept in order or repaired by any person or company having railroad tracks thereon, and also excepting such portions thereof as have already been paved, and such portions of West Citrus Avenue now occupied by a wooden culvert along the south side thereof and extending from Orange Street to a point opposite the northwest corner of Cajon Street, and also excepting 27 inches in width from the curb line on each side of said East and West Citrus Avenue, along the gutter way thereof where cobble stone gutters have been laid) shall be paved with asphaltic cement and broken stone base, with asphalt wearing surface, in accordance with plans, profile and cross sections therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Clerk, *to all of which reference is hereby made; and*

*width* (b) That one culvert be constructed along the north gutter way of East Citrus Avenue, extending across the entrance into Fifth Street. Said culvert to be a 12-inch cast iron pipe, inside measurement, and in accordance with plans therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer, and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Clerk, *to all of which reference is hereby made; and*

(c) That all cobble stone gutters along each side of said East and West Citrus Avenue, to be paved as aforesaid for a width of 27 inches from the curb line of said street (excepting along said culverts, and excepting also where already grouted or surfaced with cement) shall be grouted and surfaced with cement in accordance with the plans therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer, and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Clerk, *to all of which reference is hereby made.*

3rd. That Fifth Street, from the north line of the roadway of East Citrus Avenue to the south line of the roadway of East Central Avenue, be improved by having the following street work done thereon, to wit: (a) That the roadway of said Fifth Street, between said points,

including all intersections of streets (excepting 27 inches in width from the curb line on each side of said street along the gutterway thereof, and also such portions of said street now occupied by a wooden bridge extending across said street near East Central Avenue) be paved with asphaltic cement and broken stone base with asphalt wearing surface, in accordance with plans, profile and cross-sections therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer, and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Clerk, *to all of which reference is hereby made; and*

(b) That four culverts be constructed to be located as follows: One across the south entrance of East State Street, into Fifth Street, and to be 24 inches wide and 8 inches high; one on the east and one on the west gutter side of Fifth Street, connecting with the above culvert, and each to be 12 feet long, 12 inches wide and 8 inches high; one in the gutterway at the northeast corner of Fifth and East State Street, and to be 12 feet long on the Fifth Street side and 8 feet long on the East State Street side, and 12 inches wide and 8 inches high, all inside measurements.

All said culverts to be constructed of concrete with steel plate top, and all in accordance with plans therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer, and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Clerk, *to all of which reference is hereby made; and*

(c) That all cobble stone gutters along each side of said Fifth Street to be paved as aforesaid, for a width of 27 inches from the curb line of said street (except where already grouted or surfaced with cement and also where said culverts are to be so constructed) shall be grouted and surfaced with cement, in accordance with plans therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer, and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Clerk, *to all of which reference is hereby made.*

4th. That East State street, from the east line of the roadway of Fifth street to the west curb line of Sixth street, be improved by having the following street work done thereon to wit: (a) That the roadway of said East State street, between said points,

(excepting 27 inches in width from the curb line on each side of said street, along the gutterway thereof) shall be paved with asphaltic cement and broken stone base, with asphalt wearing surface in accordance with plans, profile and cross-sections therefor on file in the office of the city engineer, and specifications therefor on file in the office of the city clerk.

*(b) That all cobble stone gutters along each side of said East State street to be paved as aforesaid for a width of 27 inches from the curb line of said street (excepting where already grouted or surfaced with cement) shall be grouted and surfaced with cement, in accordance with plans therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer, and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Clerk, & all of which reference is hereby made;*

*all of which reference is hereby made.*

5th. That East and West Central avenue, from from the east curb line of Fourth street to the east line of Fifth street, be improved by having the following street work done thereon, to wit: (a) That the roadway of said East and West Central Avenue, between said points,

including all intersections of streets (excepting 27 inches in width from the curb line on each side of said East and West Central avenue, along the gutter way thereof, and excepting such portions of said street and intersections as have already been paved) shall be paved with asphaltic cement and broken stone base, with asphalt wearing surface, in accordance with plans, profile and cross-sections therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer, and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Clerk.

*(b) That all cobble stone gutters along each side of said East and West Central avenue, to be paved as aforesaid, for a width of 27 inches from the curb lines of said street, shall be grouted and surfaced with cement (excepting where already grouted or surfaced with cement) in accordance with plans, profile and cross-sections therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer, and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Clerk.*

The street superintendent shall post notice of this work and the passage of this resolution, as required by law, and shall cause a similar notice to be published for six days, in the manner required by law, in the Redlands Daily Facts, hereby designated for that purpose.

The city clerk shall certify the passage of this resolution and shall cause the same to be published by two insertions as required by law, in the Redlands Daily Facts, hereby designated for that purpose, and shall post the same for two days on or near the chamber door of this Board.
