Resolution of Intention No. 499

(Sixth Street Improvement)
 RESOLVED, That the public interest and convenience require, and that it is the intention of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands to order the following work to be done, and improvements to be made, to-wit:

That the roadway of North Sixth Street in said city between the gutters thereon, from and connecting with the macadam pavement on East Lugonia Avenue to and connecting with the macadam pavement on East Colton Avenue be paved with 4-inch macadam pavement with asphaltic oil wearing surface; also the removal of all cobblestone gutters and the construction of concrete gutters on both sides of said North Sixth Street between said points, where not already constructed; also the construction of concrete curbs on both sides of said North Sixth Street from East Lugonia Avenue to East Brockton Avenue, where not already constructed; also the construction of a cement sidewalk 5 feet in width on both sides of said North Sixth Street from East Lugonia Avenue to East Colton Avenue where not already constructed; also the removal of all bridges over the gutters at private driveways and the construction of concrete dip driveways on said North Sixth Street between said points; also the extension of culverts at street intersections to the property line at said intersections where not already constructed.

Said contemplated work and improvement is, in the opinion of said Board of more than local or ordinary public benefit and the expense of said work and improvement is hereby made chargeable upon the district herein after specified; that the exterior boundaries of said district hereby established and the exterior boundaries of the lands hereby declared to be benefited by said work and improvement and to be assessed to pay the cost and expenses thereof are described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of Lot 6, Block 25, Town of Lugonia Book 8 of Maps, page 7; thence north to the northwest corner of said Lot 6; thence westerly to the southwest corner of Lot 5 of said block 23; thence north to the northwest corner of Lot 25 Gerber Tract, Book 15 of Maps, page 60; thence east to the northeast corner of Lot 47, Brock and Benningsdorf Add., Book 15 of Maps, page 5; thence south to the southeast corner of Lot 11, Block 22, Town of Lugonia; thence east along the south line of said Lot 11, 43 feet; thence south to a point on the south line of Lot 9 of said Block 22, 87.58 feet east of the southwest corner of said Lot 9; thence west to the point of beginning.

The book of maps and page references hereinbefore given refer to records of maps in the office of the County Recorder, San Bernardino County, California.

All of said work mentioned shall be done and improvement made upon the grade, along the lines, between the points, of the dimensions, at the place and in the manner and as shown upon and according to the plans, profiles and detail drawings for said work and according to the specifications therefor, which said plans, profiles, detail drawings and specifications have heretofore been adopted by said board for doing said work and are now on file in the office of the city engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

The said Board of Trustees also determines and declares that serial bonds bearing interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum shall be issued to represent each assessment of \$25.00 or more remaining unpaid for thirty days after the date of the warrant as to said work.

Said serial bonds shall extend over a period of nine years from the second day of January next succeeding the 15th day of the Next November following their date. Payments on the principal of unpaid assessments and interest shall be made by property owners to the City Treasurer and the same shall be disbursed by him, all as provided in and by the Improvement Act of 1911, so-called. The principal and interest of said bonds shall be payable in the manner and as provided by said Act.

Notice is hereby given that on the 19th day of March, 1930, at 2 o'clock p. m., in the Council Chamber of said Board, any and all persons having any objections to the proposed work or improvement may appear before said Board, and show cause why said work or improvement should not be carried out in accordance with this resolution.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this resolution twice in the manner required by law, in the Redlands Daily Facts, a daily newspaper published and circulated in said city, hereby designated for that purpose.

The Superintendent of Streets of said city is hereby directed to post notices of the passage of this resolution in the time, form, manner and as required by the said "Improvement Act of 1911."

I hereby certify that the foregoing resolution was passed by said Board of Trustees on February 19, 1930, at a regular meeting thereof, by the unanimous vote of said board.
