Sixth and Vine Streets, Macadam, curb, gutter, etc.

Resolution of Intention
No. 473

(Sixth and Vine streets, macadam, curb, gutter, etc.)
RESOLVED, That the public interest and convenience require, and that it is the intention of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands to order the following work to be done, and improvement to be made, to-wit:

That the roadway of Sixth street from and connecting with the asphalt pavement on Citrus avenue to and connecting with the macadam pavement on Olive avenue, and the roadway of Vine street from Sixth street to and connecting with the asphalt pavement at the intersection of Vine street and Fifth street be paved with 4 inch macadam pavement with asphaltic oil wearing surface, where not already so paved; also the scarifying and relaying of the existing macadam pavement on Sixth street between said points; also the removal of the present cobblestone gutters on both sides of said street between said points and the construction of concrete gutters, where not already constructed; also the removal of the stone curb on both sides of said street between said points and the construction of concrete curb where not already constructed; also the removal of all bridges over the gutter and the construction of concrete dip drive-ways on said street between said points where not already constructed; also the construction of 12 inch corrugated pipe culverts at the intersection of Sixth street and Citrus avenue; also the construction of a cement sidewalk on the east side of Sixth street where not already in; also the repair of the stone curb on both sides of Vine street between Sixth street and Fifth street where the capping or face joint has been removed from any cause; also the reconstruction and resetting of the curb on both sides of said street where out of line or place from any cause.

Said contemplated work and improvement is, in the opinion of said Board, of more than local or ordinary public benefit and the expense of said work and improvement is hereby made chargeable upon the district hereinafter specified; that the exterior boundaries of said district hereby declared to be benefited by said work and improvement and to be assessed to pay the costs and expenses thereof are described as follows:

Beginning at the northeast corner of Vine street and Fifth street; thence along the east line of Fifth street north 130 feet; thence easterly to the southwest corner of Lot 4, Block A, of Subdivision of Block XXVIII of Redlands, Book 4, page 2; thence north to the northwest corner of said Lot 1; thence along the south line of Citrus avenue east 125 feet; thence south 120 feet to the southeast corner of Lot 14, Block B, of said Subdivision of Block XXVIII of Redlands; thence to a point on the north line of Lot 16 of said Block B east 135.8 feet from the east line of Sixth street; thence South 44.3 feet to a point on the southeasterly line of said Lot 16; thence, southwesterly to the northeasterly corner of Lot 19 of said Block B; thence southerly to the southeasterly corner of said Lot 19; thence along the northerly line of Olive avenue to a point 81 feet westerly from the westerly line of Sixth street; thence north 33 degrees 40 minutes West 93 feet; thence south 56 degrees 20 minutes west 50 feet; thence north 33 degrees 40 minutes west 22 feet; thence south 56 degrees 20 minutes west 55 feet; thence north 33 degrees 40 minutes west 20 feet; thence south 56 degrees 20 minutes west to the southwest corner of Lot 6, Block C of Subdivision of Block XXVIII of Redlands; thence north 33 degrees 40 minutes west 60 feet; thence south 56 degrees 20 minutes west 50 feet to the westerly line of Lot 7 of said Block C; thence northerly along said westerly line of Lot 7 to the south line of Vine street; thence to the point of beginning.

The Book of Maps and page references hereinbefore given refer to records of maps in the office of the County Recorder of San Bernardino County, California.

All of said work mentioned shall be done and improvement made upon the grade, along the lines, between the points, of the dimensions, at the place and in the manner and as shown upon and according to the plans, profiles and detail drawings for said work and according to the specifications therefor, which said plans, profiles, detail drawings and specifications have heretofore been adopted by said board for doing said work and are now on file in the office of the city engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

The said Board of Trustees also determines and declares that serial bonds bearing interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum shall be issued to represent each assessment of \$25.00 or more, remaining unpaid for thirty days after the date of the warrant as to said work.

Said serial bonds shall extend over a period of nine years from the second day of January next succeeding the 15th day of the next November following their date. Payments on the principal of unpaid assessments and interest shall be made by property owners to the City Treasurer and the same shall be disbursed by him, all as provided.
