

**Notice of Public Work
No. 467**

Widening of Sixth Street from
Vine Street to Citrus Avenue.

Public Notice is hereby given that on the 15th day of February, 1928, the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands adopted Resolution of Intention No. 467 to order the following street work to be done, to-wit: The widening of Sixth Street from Vine Street to Citrus Avenue.

That the land necessary and convenient to be taken for said widening and which said Board intends to take therefor is situated in said city and particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the northwest corner of Lot 15, Block B, Sub. of Block XXVIII of Redlands, Book 4, page 2, San Bernardino County Records, California; thence east along the north line of said Lot 15, 10 feet; thence south 10 feet from and parallel with the west line of said Lot 15 and the west line of Lots 16, 17 and 18 of said Block B to its intersection with the easterly line of Sixth Street; thence northerly along the easterly line and north along the east line of Sixth Street to the point of beginning.

That the exterior boundaries of the district hereby established and the exterior boundaries of the district of lands hereby declared to be affected and benefited by such opening and extension and to be assessed to pay the damages, costs and expenses thereof are hereby fixed and determined and described as follows: Beginning at the northwest corner of Lot 15, Block B, Sub. of Block XXVIII of Redlands, Book 4, page 2, San Bernardino County Records, California; thence to the northeast corner of Lot 12 of said Block B; thence to the southeast corner of said Lot 12; thence to a point on the north line of Lot 16 135.8 feet east of the northwest corner of said lot; thence to the northeast corner of Lot 22 of said Block B; thence to the southwest corner of Lot 18 of said Block B; thence to the southwest corner of Lot 35, Block A, Sub. of Block XXVIII of Redlands; thence to the northwest corner of said Lot 35; thence to the southwest corner of Lot 1 of said Block A; thence north to the northwest corner of said Lot 1; thence east to the point of beginning.
