on Opening and Widening of Syl-
van Blvd. from Church Street to
Judson street.

Notice is hereby given that Com-
missioners appointed by the Board of
Councilmen of the City of Redlands
to assess the benefits and damages
and to have general supervision of
the proposed work of Opening and
Widening Sylvan boulevard in said
city under Resolution of Intention
No. 484 having made their assess-
ments of benefits and damages, have
made and filed in the office of the
undersigned their written report.

All persons interested are hereby
notified and required to show cause,
if any they have, on or before the
17th day of June, 1929, why said re-
port and plat should not be con-
firmed and approved by said Board
of Councilmen.

All objections must be in writing
and filed with the Clerk of said

Notice of Public Work No. 475 Sylvan Boulevard Widen- ing.

Public Notice is hereby given that
on the 1st day of August, 1928, the
Board of Trustees of the City of
Redlands adopted Resolution of In-
tention No. 475 to order the fol-
lowing street work to be done, to-
wit: The opening and widening of
Sylvan Boulevard from Church street
to Judson street, where not already
a public street.

That the land necessary and con-
venient to be taken for said open-
ing and widening and which said
Board intends to take therefore is
situated in said city and particular-
ly described as follows, to-wit:

Thirty (30) feet on either side
of the following described line: Be-
ginning at a point in the center line
of University street being South 0
degrees 12 minutes East 886.71 feet
from its intersection with the cen-
ter line of Colton avenue; thence
north 71 degrees 40 minutes East
166 feet; thence on a curve to the
right having a radius of 815.04 feet,
238.27 feet; thence north 88 degrees
25 minutes east 127.13 feet; thence
on a curve to the right having a
radius of 700 feet, 272.24 feet;
thence south 69 degrees 18 minutes
east 86.07 feet; thence on a curve
to the left having a radius of 700
feet, 224.18 feet; thence south 87 de-
grees 39 minutes east 112.14 feet to
a point in the center line of Cook
street being south 0 degrees 24
minutes east 922.9 feet from its in-
tersection with the center line of
Colton avenue; thence north 82 de-
grees 05 minutes east 91.5 feet;
thence on a curve to the right hav-
ing a radius of 329.57 feet, 178.60
feet; thence on a curve to the left
having a radius of 308.57 feet, 177.81
feet; thence north 80 degrees 07
minutes east 291.50 feet to a point
in the center line of Grove street
being south 0 degrees 09 minutes
east 908.3 feet from its intersection
with the center line of Colton ave-
nue; thence south 78 degrees 42
minutes east 191.2 feet; thence on a
curve to the left having a radius of
1000 feet, 216.71 feet; thence north
85 degrees 53 minutes east 361.48
feet; thence on a curve to the left
having a radius of 651.56 feet, 275.95
feet; thence north 64 degrees 37
minutes east 54.75 feet; thence on a
curve to the right having a radius
of 424.24 feet, 119.08 feet; thence
north 80 degrees 42 minutes east 37
feet to a point in the center line of
Judson street being south 0 de-
grees 33 minutes east 837.87 feet
from its intersection with the center
line of Colton avenue; also all of
lots 9 and 12 and those portions of
lots 10, 11 not heretofore dedicated
for street purposes as per map of
Woodlawn Tract as recorded in
Book 15 of Maps, page 56, San
Bernardino County Records, Califor-
nia.

That the exterior boundaries of
the district hereby established and
the exterior boundaries of the dis-
trict of land hereby declared to be
affected and benefitted by said work
or improvement and to be assessed
to pay the damages, costs and ex-
penses thereof, are hereby determi-
ned to be the exterior boundaries of
said city and the said Board of
Trustees hereby deems it proper
that the boundaries of the district
of land to be affected and assessed
to pay the whole of the damages,
costs and expenses of said work or
improvement shall include the whole
of said city, and it is hereby declar-
ed that such district shall include
and embrace the whole of said city.
Reference is hereby made to said
Resolution of Intention for further
particulars.
