Resolution No. 459, Sidewalks on E. Citrus, Stillman,

Resolution of Intention No. 459

(Sidewalk on E. Citrus, Stillman,
Occidental, Webster, E. Colton
W. Vine)

RESOLVED, That the public interest and convenience require, and that it is the intention of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands to order the following work to be done, and improvement to be made, to-wit:

That a cement sidewalk five feet in width be constructed on the south side of East Citrus Avenue in said city from and connecting with the existing sidewalk at the west line of the storm water ditch along the G. Huizing Subdivision, easterly to Cypress Avenue, excepting the roadway of each intersecting street; also the construction of a cement sidewalk six feet in width on the south side of Stillman Avenue in said city between Church Street and Division Street where not already in; also the construction of a cement sidewalk six feet in width on the north side of Stillman Avenue between Church Street and the west line of the alleyway east of Block 1, Map of Lugonia Heights; also the construction of a cement sidewalk six feet in width on the south side of Colton Avenue between Church Street and Division Street where not already in; also the construction of a cement sidewalk five feet in width on the east side of Occidental Drive between Colton Avenue and College Avenue where not already in; also the construction of a cement sidewalk five feet in width on the west side of Webster Street between Colton Avenue and Union Avenue where not already in, excepting the roadway of each intersecting street; also that the space between the curb and the present sidewalk on the southerly side of Vine Street between Canon Street and Fourth Street be filled in with sidewalk where not already in.

The expense incurred for said work shall be assessed upon the lots and lands fronting thereon.

All of said work mentioned shall be done and improvement made upon the grade, along the lines, between the points, of the dimensions, at the place and in the manner and as shown upon and according to the plans, profiles and details drawings for said work and according to the specifications therefor, which said plans, profiles, detail drawings and specifications have heretofore been adopted by said board for doing said work and are now on file in the office of the city engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

The said Board of Trustees also determines and declares—that serial bonds bearing interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum shall be issued to represent each assessment of \$25.00 or more remaining unpaid for thirty days after the date of the warrant as to said work.

Said serial bonds shall extend over a period of nine years from the second day of January next succeeding the 15th day of the Next November following their date. Payments on the principal of unpaid assessments and interest shall be made by property owners to the City Treasurer and the same shall be disbursed by him, all as provided in and by the Improvement Act of 1911, so-called. The principal and interest of said bonds shall be payable in the manner and as provided by said Act.

Notice is hereby given that on the 7th day of December, 1927, at 2 o'clock p. m., in the Council Chamber of said Board, any and all persons having any objections to the proposed work or improvement may appear before said Board, and show cause why said work or improvement should not be carried out in accordance with this resolution.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this resolution twice in the manner required by law, in the Redlands Daily Facts, a daily newspaper published and circulated in said city, hereby designated for that purpose.

The Superintendent of Streets of said city is hereby directed to post notices of the passage of this resolution in the time, form, manner and as required by the said "Improvement Act of 1911."

I hereby certify that the foregoing resolution was passed by said Board of Trustees on November 2, 1927, at a regular meeting thereof, by the unanimous vote of said board.
