Pursuant to statute and to the resolution of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, directing this notice—

Notice is hereby given that the said Board, in open session, on the 1st day of October, 1924, publicly opened, examined and declared all sealed proposals or bids for doing the work and improvement in said City, as described in Resolution of Intention No. 360, of said City, adopted on the 19th day of March, 1924, which resolution of intention is hereby expressly referred to for further particulars.

And notice is also hereby given that said Board thereafter, on the 1st day of October, 1924, awarded the contract for said work to the lowest regular responsible bidder, to-wit: Geo. S. Abrahamson, at the prices named for said work in his proposal therefor, as follows:

For the work specified in Item 1 of said resolution, 16½ cents per square foot, and for the work specified in Item 2 thereof, 16 cents per square foot.

NOTICE INVITING
SEALED PROPOSALS

(Item 1, Paving Alley in Block 6,
Town Plat)

Pursuant to statute and resolution of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, adopted on the 16th day of April, 1924, directing this notice, the undersigned invites and will receive at his office, in said City, up to two o'clock p. m. on the 7th day of May, 1924, sealed proposals or bids, for the following street work, to be done according to specifications therefor, posted and on file, adopted for said work, as herein mentioned, to-wit:

Item 1. That the roadway of the alley in Block Six (6) Town Plat of Redlands be paved with cement concrete pavement.

All of said work shall be done in accordance with the plans, specifications, profiles and cross-sections therefor, heretofore adopted for doing said work, and now on file in the office of the City Engineer of said City, to all of which reference is hereby made.

The said Board of Trustees also determines and declares that serial bonds bearing interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum shall be issued to represent each assessment of \$25.00 or more remaining unpaid for twenty days after the date of the warrant as to each of said items.

Said serial bonds shall extend over a period of nine years from the second day of January next succeeding the 15th day of November following their date. Payments on the principal of unpaid assessments and interest shall be made by property owners to the City Treasurer and the same shall be disbursed by him, all as provided in and by the Improvement Act of 1911, so-called.

Bidders must file with each proposal or bid, a check payable to said City, certified by a responsible bank, for an amount which shall not be less than ten per cent of the aggregate of the proposal, or a bond for the said amount and so payable, signed by the bidder and two sureties, who shall justify before any officer competent to administer an oath, in double the said amount, and over and above all statutory exemptions.

Bids will be opened on the 7th day of May, 1924, at 2 o'clock, p. m., and if a contract for said work be not then awarded, further bids will be received at any subsequent meeting of said Board until a contract therefor shall be awarded.
