

Notice Inviting Sealed
Proposals, No. 420

(Brookside Ave.)

Pursuant to Statute and to Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, directing this notice, said Board hereby invites sealed proposals or bids for doing the following work in said City, to-wit:

That the roadway of Brookside Avenue in said city from the easterly line of Eureka Street produced across said Brookside Avenue to the westerly city limits, including the roadway of all street intersections to the property line of Brookside Avenue produced across such intersections between said points, and also the roadway of all crossings through the parking space in the center of Brookside Avenue be paved with 4 inch macadam pavement with asphaltic oil wearing surface; that that portion of the present pavement on Brookside Avenue where not already paved, adjacent to the new pavement and where adjacent to the reconstructed gutters, be scarified and resurfaced in order that the new and old work may be bonded together with an even grade; also the construction of concrete curbs along both sides of the parking spaces in the center of Brookside Avenue and connecting the ends of the curb on each side around the parking space at each of the driveways crossing said parking space; also the reconstruction of the gutters on both sides of Brookside Avenue between the westerly line of Eureka Street produced across said Brookside Avenue and the westerly line of Center Street produced across Brookside Avenue; also the repair of the curb wherever the capping or face joint has been removed from any cause on both sides of Brookside Avenue between said Eureka Street and Center Street; and also the construction of concrete bridges over the storm water ditches, together with guard rail and curb and gutter over and along said storm water ditches; and also the removal of all bridges over the gutter and the construction of concrete dip driveways between the gutter and sidewalk at private driveways on both sides of said Brookside Avenue.

Said contemplated work and improvement is, in the opinion of said Board of more than local or ordinary public benefit and therefore the expense of said work and improvement is hereby made chargeable upon the district described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the northeasterly corner of Lot 1, Ladd's 1st Addition; thence southerly along the easterly line of said lot, 75 feet; thence westerly 75 feet from and paralleled with the southerly line of Brookside Avenue to the westerly line of Lot 3 of said addition; thence southerly to the southwest corner of said Lot 3; thence westerly to the southwest corner of Lot 1, Ladd's 2nd Addition; thence to the southeasterly corner of Lot 1, Parkwood Addition; thence westerly to the southwest corner of Lot 12 of said addition; thence to the southeasterly corner of Lot 2, Stewart's Addition; thence westerly to the southwest corner of Lot 1 of said addition; thence to the southeasterly corner of Lot 1, Pettit's 1st Addition; thence westerly along the southerly line of said addition to the southwest corner of Lot 11 of said addition; thence westerly 160 feet from and parallel with the southerly line of Brookside Avenue to the westerly limits of the City of Redlands; thence northerly along the westerly limits of the City of Redlands to a point 150 feet from the northerly line of Brookside Avenue when measured at right angles thereto; thence easterly 150 feet from and parallel with the northerly line of Brookside Avenue to a point on the westerly line of Lot 6, Peller's Sub. No. 2; thence northerly along the westerly line of said lot to the northwesterly corner thereof; thence easterly 160 feet from and parallel with the northerly line of Brookside Avenue to the northeasterly corner of Lot 1, Brookside Avenue Subdivision; thence to the southeasterly corner of said lot 1; thence to the point of beginning.

All of said work mentioned shall be done and improvement made upon the grade, along the lines, between the points, of the dimensions, at the place and in the manner and as shown upon and according to the plans, profiles and detail drawings for said work and according to the specifications therefor, which said plans, profiles, detail drawings and specifications have heretofore been adopted by said board for doing said work and are now on file in the office of the city engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

The said Board of Trustees also determines and declares that serial bonds bearing interest at the rate of seven percent per annum shall be issued to represent each assessment of \$25.00 or more remaining unpaid for twenty days after the date of the warrant as to each of said respective item of work.

Said serial bonds shall extend over a period of nine years from the second day of January next succeeding the 15th day of November following their date. Payments on the principal of unpaid assessments and interest shall be made by property owners to the City Treasurer and the same shall be disbursed by him, all as provided in and by the Improvement Act of 1911, so-called.
