

NOTICE INVITING SEALED PROPOSALS

No. 427

(Brookside Avenue Improvement.)

Pursuant to Statute and to Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, directing this notice, said Board hereby invites sealed proposals or bids for doing the following work in said City, to-wit:

That the roadway of Brookside Avenue in said city from the easterly line of Eureka Street produced across said Brookside Avenue to the westerly city limits, including the roadway of all street intersections to the property line of Brookside Avenue produced across said intersections between said points, and also the roadway of all crossings thru the Brookside Avenue wherever said roadway is not already paved, be paved with 4 inch macadam pavement with asphaltic oil wearing surface; that that portion of the present pavement on Brookside Avenue where it becomes adjacent to the new pavement and where it becomes adjacent to the reconstructed gutters, be scarified and resurfaced in order that the new and old work may be bonded together with an even grade; that concrete curbs be constructed along both sides of the parking spaces in the center of Brookside Avenue and connecting the ends of the curbs on each side around the parking spaces at each of the driveways crossing said parking space; that the gutters on both sides of Brookside Avenue between the westerly line of Eureka Street produced across said Brookside Avenue and the westerly line of Center Street produced across said Brookside Avenue be reconstructed; that the present curbs on Brookside Avenue between the westerly line of Eureka Street produced across said Brookside Avenue and the westerly line of Center Street produced across said Brookside Avenue be repaired wherever the capping or face joint has been removed from any cause; that three concrete culvert extensions be constructed over the storm water drains or ditches crossing said Brookside Avenue between the westerly line of Eureka Street produced across said Brookside Avenue and the westerly city limits, together with guard rail curb and gutter on said concrete culvert extensions over and along said storm water ditches; that on both sides of said Brookside Avenue between the westerly line of Eureka Street produced across said Brookside Avenue and the westerly city limits certain driveway bridges over the gutters be removed and that concrete dip driveways be constructed at such points between the gutter and sidewalk; and also that concrete dip driveways be constructed on both sides of Brookside Avenue between said points to enter upon private property where such driveways are not already constructed.

Said contemplated work and improvement is, in the opinion of the said Board of more than local or ordinary public benefit and therefore the expense of said work and improvement is hereby made chargeable upon the district described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the northeasterly corner of Lot 1, Ladd's 1st Addition; thence southerly along the easterly line of said lot, 75 feet; thence westerly 75 feet from and parallel with the southerly line of Brookside Avenue to the westerly line of Lot 3 of said Addition; thence southerly to the southwesterly corner of said Lot 3; thence westerly to the southwesterly corner of Lot 1, Ladd's 2nd Addition; thence to the southeasterly corner of Lot 1, Parkwood Addition; thence westerly to the southwesterly corner of Lot 12 of said Addition; thence to the southeasterly corner of Lot 2, Stewart's Addition; thence westerly to the southwesterly corner of Lot 1 of said Addition; thence to the southeasterly corner of Lot 1, Pettit's 1st Addition; thence westerly along the southerly line of said Addition to the southwesterly corner of Lot 11 of said Addition; thence westerly 160 feet from and parallel with the southerly line of Brookside Avenue to the westerly limits of the City of Redlands; thence northerly along the westerly limits of the City of Redlands to a point 150 feet from the northerly line of Brookside Avenue when measured at right angles thereto; thence easterly 150 feet from and parallel with the northerly line of Brookside Avenue to a point on the westerly line of Lot 6, Peller's Sub. No. 2; thence northerly along the westerly line of said lot to the northwesterly corner thereof; thence easterly 160 feet from and parallel with the northerly line of Brookside Avenue to the northwesterly corner of Lot 1, Brookside Avenue Subdivision; thence to the southeasterly corner of said lot 1; thence to the point of beginning.

All of said work mentioned shall be done and improvement made upon the lines, be-

bonds bearing interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum shall be issued to represent each assessment of \$25.00 or more remaining unpaid for twenty days after the date of the warrant as to said work.

Said serial bonds shall extend over a period of nine years from the second day of January next succeeding the 15th day of the next November following their date. Payments on the principal of unpaid assessments and interest shall be made by property owners to the City Treasurer and the same shall be disbursed by him, all as provided in and by the Improvement Act of 1911, so-called. The principal and interest of said bonds shall be payable in the manner and as provided by said Act.

Reference is hereby made to Resolution of Intention No. 427 of said City, declaring its intention to order said work to be done, for further particulars, which Resolution is on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City, and reference is hereby further made to the specifications for said work posted and on file.

All proposals or bids shall be accompanied by a check payable to the City of Redlands, certified by a responsible bank for an amount which shall not be less than ten per cent of the aggregate of the proposal, or by a bond for said amount and so payable, signed by the bidder and two sureties, who shall justify, before any officer competent to administer an oath, in double the said amount, and over and above all statutory exemptions.

Said proposals or bids shall be delivered to the Clerk of said City, on or before two o'clock P. M., on the 15th day of September, 1926, and if a contract for said work be not then awarded, further bids will be received at any subsequent meeting of said Board until a contract therefor shall be awarded.
