

NOTICE INVITING SEALED PROPOSALS.

Pursuant to Statute and Resolution of Intention, No. 254, of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, adopted November 7, 1906, directing this notice, the undersigned invites and will receive at his office in the Y. M. C. A. Building in said City, sealed proposals or bids for the following street work to be done, to-wit:

First: That the roadway of Brookside Avenue from the southwest line of Citrus Avenue to the West boundard line of said City, including all intersections of streets, excepting the gutterway on each side of said street, and also excepting a space of twenty-eight feet in width, being fourteen feet on either side of the middle line of said street, shall be macadamized with crushed rock base, coated with liquid asphalt wearing surface, in accordance with plans, profiles, cross sections and specifications therefor, on file in the office of the City Engineer of said City, to all of which reference is hereby made.

Second: That the roadway of Sixth street from the south line of Citrus Avenue to a point 12 feet north of the center line of Olive Avenue, for a width of 12 feet on each side of the center line thereof, including all intersections of streets and alleyways, shall be macadamized with crushed rock base, coated with liquid asphalt wearing surface, in accordance with plans, profiles, cross-sections and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer of said City, to all of which reference is hereby made.

The bids for said work must be separate and the bidder must file with each proposal or bid, a check payable to the order of the President of the Board of Trustees of said City, certified by a responsible bank, for an amount which shall not be less than ten per cent of the aggregate of the proposal, or a bond for the said amount and so payable, signed by the bidder and by two sureties, who shall justify before any officer competent to administer an oath, in double the said amount and over and above all statutory exemptions.

Notice is given to all such bidders that the amount to be paid by said City therefor, shall not exceed one-half of the total cost thereof and that the other half of such cost is to be paid by the property owners having property abutting upon said street where said work is to be done and by private contract between such property owners and such contractor to be obtained by such contractor.

Bids will be received up to two o'clock p.m. on the 21st day of November, 1906, at which time bids will be opened, and if no bids therefor be accepted, bids will be thereafter received at any subsequent meeting of said Board, until satisfactory bids for said work shall be received and accepted for said work.
