Paving of alley through Block 10 of the Town Plat of Redlands

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**Resolution of Inten-
tion No. 314**

Resolved, That the public interest and convenience require, and that it is the intention of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands to order the following street work to be done upon that certain alleyway in Block Ten of Town Plat of Redlands, extending from the south line of Central avenue to the west line of Fifth street, to-wit: That the whole of said alleyway be paved with concrete pavement, except the bridge thereon.

All according to plans, specifications, profiles and cross-sections thereof, and as shown upon said plans, all on file in the office of the City Engineer of said City, to all of which reference is hereby made.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this resolution by two insertions, in the manner required by law, in the Redlands Daily Facts, a daily newspaper published and circulated in said city, hereby designated for that purpose.

The Superintendent of Streets of said City is hereby directed to post notice of the passage of this resolution in the manner and form and as required by law.
