(Central Avenue, etc., east of Seventh Street)

Pursuant to statute and to the resolution of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, directing this notice—
Notice is hereby given that the said Board, in open session, on the 5th day of February, 1926, publicly opened, examined and declared all sealed proposals or bids for doing the work and improvement in said City, as described in Resolution of Intention No. 410, of said City, adopted on the 2nd day of December, 1925, which resolution of intention is hereby expressly referred to for further particulars.
And notice is also hereby given that said Board thereafter, on 5th day of February, 1926, awarded the contract for said work to the lowest regular responsible bidder, to-wit: Geo. Gardner, Jr., at: sidewalk per square foot 15 cents; gutter, 5' per square foot, 15 cents; curb, recapped 20 cents; new stone curb 45 cents; curb reconstructed 40 cents; concrete drives per square foot 15.5 cents; concrete dips per square foot 15.5 cents; sidewalk patches per square foot 17 cents; the prices named for said work in his proposal or bid on file.

Said serial bonds shall extend over a period of nine years from the second day of January next succeeding the 15th day of the next November following their date. Payment on the principal of unpaid assessments and interest shall be made by property owners to the City Treasurer and the same shall be disbursed by him, all as provided in and by the Improvement Act of 1911, so-called. The principal and interest of said bonds shall be payable in the manner and as provided by said Act.

Reference is hereby made to Resolution of Intention No. 410 of said City, declaring its intention to order said work to be done, for further particulars, which Resolution is on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City, and reference is hereby further made to the specifications for said work posted and on file.

All proposals or bids shall be accompanied by a check payable to the City of Redlands, certified by a responsible bank for an amount which shall not be less than ten per cent of the aggregate of the proposal, or by a bond for the said amount and so payable, signed by the bidder and two sureties, who shall justify, before any officer competent to administer an oath, in double the said amount, and over and above all statutory exemptions.

Said proposals or bids shall be delivered to the Clerk of said City, on or before two o'clock P. M., on the 3rd day of February, 1926, and if a contract for said work be not then awarded, further bids will be received at any subsequent meeting of said Board until a contract therefor shall be awarded.

Pursuant to Statute and to Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, directing this notice, said Board hereby invites sealed proposals or bids for doing the following work in said City, to-wit:

The reconstruction of the gutters on both sides of State Street from Seventh Street to Church Street; and also the removal of all bridges over the gutters and the construction of concrete dip driveways between the gutters and sidewalks at all private driveways; and also the repair of the curb wherever the capping or face joint has been removed from any cause; also the reconstruction of gutters on both sides of Central Avenue from Seventh Street to Church Street; And also the removal of all bridges over the gutters and the construction of concrete dip driveways between the gutters and sidewalks at all private driveways; and also the repair of the curb wherever the capping or face joint has been removed from any cause; and also the construction of a cement sidewalk 5 feet in width on the west side of Church Street from Citrus Avenue to the South line of Sylvan Boulevard produced across said Church Street, where not already constructed and excepting therefrom such portions thereof as is required by law to be kept in order or repair by any person or company having railroad tracks thereon; and also the construction of stone curbs and concrete gutters on the west side of Church Street from Citrus Avenue to the South line of Sylvan Boulevard produced across said Church Street, where not already constructed and excepting therefrom such portions thereof as is required by law to be kept in order or repair by any person or company having railroad tracks thereon; also the reconstruction of the gutters on the west side of Church Street from Citrus Avenue to the south line of Sylvan Boulevard produced across said Church Street; and also the removal of all bridges over the gutters and the construction of concrete dip driveways between the gutters and the sidewalk at all private driveways; and also the repair of the curb wherever the cap or face joint has been removed from any cause.

All of said work mentioned shall be done and improvement made upon the grade, along the lines, between the points, of the dimensions, at the place and in the manner and as shown upon and according to the plans, profiles and detail drawings for said work according to the specifications therefor, which said plans, profiles, detail drawings and specifications have heretofore been adopted by said Board for doing said work and are now on file in the office of the city engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

Said contemplated work and improvement is, in the opinion of said Board, of more than local or ordinary public benefit and therefore the expense of said work and improvement is hereby made chargeable upon the district described as follows, to-wit:
