

Resolution of Inter-
Ordering the constructi-
walk on the south

Resolved, That the public interest and convenience require, and that it is the intention of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands to order the following street work to be done, to-wit:

1st. The construction of cement sidewalk along the south side of Colton Avenue from Granger Street to Sybil Street, there not already constructed, according to plans and specifications, thereon, and as shown upon said plans, all on file in the office of the city engineer of said city, to which reference is hereby made.

That the work of constructing said cement sidewalk is, in the opinion of said board, of more than local and ordinary public benefit, and that the expense of said work was made chargeable upon the district hereinafter specified; that the exterior boundaries of said district established and the exterior boundaries of the lands hereby declared to be benefited by said work and improvement and to be assessed to pay the costs and expenses thereof are described as follows:

Said district is situated within the City of Redlands, County of San Bernardino, State of California, and particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the northeast corner of Lot 1, McQuinn's Subdivision; thence west along the north line of Colton Avenue to the northwest corner of Lot 9 of said Subdivision; thence south along the west line of said Lot 9 to the southwest corner thereof; thence east in right angles to the southeast corner of Lot 8, said Subdivision; thence north along the east line of said Lot 8 to the southwest corner of said Lot 1; thence east at right angles to the west line of Granger Street; thence north to the place of beginning.

Setting and erecting and excluding location all public streets.

The McQuinn's Subdivision referred to in said order is according to a map hereby of record in the office of the County Recorder of the said County of San Bernardino, and referred to by the name of such map for the purpose of identification of the location described in said district. The said map, filed at 2 o'clock p. m., of the 12th day of April, 1914, at the County Clerk's Office of said Board, and said work any and all persons engaged in the same to the said project work of improvement may apply to the Board and show cause why said proposed improvement should not be carried out in accordance with the above resolution.

That the Clerk is hereby directed to publish the resolution twice in the Redlands Standard, a daily newspaper published and circulated in said city, and to publish the same for that purpose, and to publish in the Streets of said city, being ordered to himself publish a copy of the message of the Board, in the manner and form herein provided for by law.
