NOTICE OF AWARD OF CONTRACT

No. 363

(Items 1, 2, 3—W. Cypress Ave.;
Eleventh St.; Bow B. St.)

Pursuant to statute and to the resolution of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, directing this notice is hereby given that the said Board, in open session, on the 16th day of July, 1924, publicly opened, examined and declared all sealed proposals or bids for doing the work and improvement in said City, as described in Resolution of Intention No. 363, of said May, 1924, which resolution of intention is hereby expressly referred to for further particulars.

And notice is also hereby given that said Board thereafter, on the 16th day of July, 1924, awarded the contract for said work to the lowest regular responsible bidder, to-wit: Geo. S. Abrahamson, at the prices named for said work in his bid on file as follows:

Seventeen cents per square foot for the work specified in item 1 of said Resolution of Intention; eighty-five cents per lineal foot for the curb and gutter work specified in item 2 of said Resolution and sixteen cents per square foot for the sidewalk work specified therein; and \$160.00 for the work specified in item 3 of said Resolution.

Notice Inviting Sealed Proposals

No. 363

(Items 1-2-3)

Pursuant to Statute and to Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, directing this notice, said Board hereby invites sealed proposals or bids for doing the following work in said City, to-wit:

Item 1

That cement concrete sidewalks shall be constructed on both sides of Cypress Avenue, in said City, between Alvarado Street and Eureka Street, where not already constructed to the official grade thereof.

Item 2

That cement concrete gutters and side walks and stone curb shall be constructed along the west side of Eleventh Street in said City, between the north line of Central Avenue, and the north line of Lot 23, in the Arcadia Addition to said City, (produced across said 11th Street) where not already constructed to the official grade thereof.

Item 3

That a stone retaining wall or curb, shall be constructed and built along that portion of Bow B Street, in said City, beginning at the intersection of the Easterly line of Lot 8, in Block 20 of Map No. 2, Redlands Heights, with the northerly line of Bow B Street, thence southwesterly 175 feet, along the northerly line of said Bow B Street.

All of said work shall be done in accordance with and as shown on the plans, profiles, detail drawings and specifications therefor, heretofore adopted for doing said work, and now on file in the office of the City Engineer of said City, to all of which reference is hereby made. Said contemplated work and improvement, as to each of said respective items of work, is, in the opinion of said Board, of more than local or ordinary public benefit; and therefore the expense of each such item of said work and improvement is hereby made chargeable upon the respective districts hereinafter specified; that the exterior boundaries of each of said respective districts hereby established and declared to be benefitted by each such item of work and improvement, and to be assessed to pay the cost and expenses thereof, is indicated and shown by a brown boundary line surrounding each such district, and lands declared benefitted by each such item of work, which line shows and indicates the exterior boundaries and extent of the territory included in each such district, upon a separate plat showing the lands embraced within each such district, and being marked "Plans," (being the plans for each of said respective items of said work aforesaid,) and being on file in the office of said City Engineer, to which respective plans reference is hereby made.

The said Board of Trustees also determines and declares that serial bonds bearing interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum shall be issued to represent each assessment of \$25.00 or more remaining unpaid for twenty days after the date of the warrant as to each of said respective item of work.

Said serial bonds shall extend over a period of nine years from the second day of January next succeeding the 15th day of November following their date. Payments on the principal of unpaid assessments and interest shall be made by property owners to the City Treasurer and the same shall be disbursed by him, all as provided in and by the Improvement Act of 1911, so-called.

Reference is hereby made to Resolution of Intention No. 363 of said City, declaring its intention to order said work to be done, for further particulars, which Resolution is on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City, and reference is hereby further made to the specifications for said work posted and on file.

All proposals or bids shall be accompanied by a check payable to the City of Redlands, certified by a responsible bank for an amount which shall not be less than ten per cent of the aggregate of the proposal, or by a bond for the said amount and so payable, signed by the bidder and two sureties, who shall justify, before any officer competent to administer an oath, in double the said amount, and over and above all statutory exemptions.

Said proposals or bids shall be delivered to the Clerk of said City, on or before two o'clock P. M., on the 2nd day of July, 1924, and if a contract for said work be not then awarded, further bids will be received at any subsequent meeting of said Board until a contract therefor
