Proposals

(Daisy Avenue, curbs and gutters.)
Pursuant to Statute and to Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, directing this notice, said Board hereby invites sealed proposals or bids for doing the following work in said City, to-wit:

The construction of concrete curbs and gutters along the south-westerly side of Daisy Avenue from and connecting with the culvert near the northeasterly corner of Lot V, Craft's Map, to the intersection of the easterly line of Lot XXV, produced across said Daisy Avenue gutter line.

All of said work mentioned shall be done and improvement made upon the grades, along the lines, between the points, of the dimensions, at the places and in the manner and as shown upon and according to the plans, profiles and detail drawings for said work and according to the specifications therefor, which said plans, profiles, detail drawings and specifications have heretofore been adopted by said Board for doing said work and are now on file in the office of the city engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

Said contemplated work and improvement, is, in the opinion of said Board, of more than local or ordinary public benefit; and therefore the expense of said work and improvement is hereby made chargeable upon the district hereinafter specified; that the exterior boundaries of said district hereby established and declared to be benefited by such work and improvement, and to be assessed to pay the cost and expenses thereof, is indicated and shown by a brown boundary line surrounding such district and lands declared benefited by such work, which line shows and indicates the exterior boundaries and extent of the territory included in such district, upon a separate plat showing the lands embraced within such district and being marked "Assessment District", (being the assessment district for said work aforesaid, and being on file in the office of said City Engineer, to which assessment district reference is hereby made.

The said Board of Trustees also determines and declares that serial bonds bearing interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum shall be issued to represent each assessment of \$25.00 or more remaining unpaid for twenty days after the date of the warrant as to each of said respective item of work.

Said serial bonds shall extend over a period of nine years from the second day of January next succeeding the 15th day of November following their date. Payments on the principal of unpaid assessments and interest shall be made by property owners to the City Treasurer and the same shall be disbursed by him, all as provided in and by the Improvement Act of 1911, so-called. The principal and interest of said Bonds shall be payable in the manner and as provided by said Act.

Reference is hereby made to Resolution of Intention No. 385 of said City, declaring its intention to order said work to be done, for further particulars which Resolution is on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City, and reference is hereby further made to the specifications for said work posted and on file.

All proposals or bids shall be accompanied by a check payable to the City of Redlands, certified by a responsible bank, for an amount which shall not be less than ten per cent of the aggregate of the proposal, or by a bond for the said amount and so payable, signed by the bidder and two sureties, who shall justify, before any officer competent to administer an oath, in double the said amount, and over and above all statutory exemptions. Said proposals or bids shall be delivered to the Clerk of said City, on or before two o'clock p. m. on the 8th day of June, 1925, and if a contract for said work be not then awarded, further bids will be received at any subsequent meeting of said Board until a contract therefor shall be awarded.

Resolution of Intention

(Daisy Avenue curb and gutter.)

RESOLVED, That the public interest and convenience require, and that it is the intention of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands to order the following work to be done, and improvement to be made, to-wit:

The construction of concrete curbs and gutters along the south-westerly side of Daisy Avenue from and connecting with the culvert near the northeasterly corner of Lot V, Craft's Map, to the intersection of the easterly line of Lot XXV, produced across said Daisy Avenue gutter line.

All of said work mentioned shall be done and improvement made upon the grades, along the lines, between the points, of the dimensions, at the places and in the manner and as shown upon and according to the plans, profiles, and detail drawings for said work and according to the specifications therefor, which said plans, profiles, detail drawings and specifications have heretofore been adopted by said Board for doing said work and are now on file in the office of the city engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

Said contemplated work and improvement, is, in the opinion of said Board, of more than local or ordinary public benefit; and therefore the expense of said work and improvement is hereby made chargeable upon the district hereinafter specified; that the exterior boundaries of said district hereby established and declared to be benefited by such work and improvement, and to be assessed to pay the cost and expenses thereof, is indicated and shown by a brown boundary line surrounding such district and lands declared benefited by such work, which line shows and indicates the exterior boundaries and extent of the territory included in such district, upon a separate plat showing the lands embraced within such district and being marked "Assessment District", (being the assessment district for said work aforesaid, and being on file in the office of said City Engineer, to which assessment district reference is hereby made.

Payments on the principal of unpaid assessments and interest shall be made by property owners to the City Treasurer and the same shall be disbursed by him, all as provided in and by the Improvement Act of 1911, so-called. The principal and interest of said Bonds shall be payable in the manner and as provided by said Act.

Notice is hereby given that on the 6th day of May, 1925, at 2 o'clock p. m., in the Council Chamber of said Board, any and all persons having any objections to the proposed work or improvement may appear before said Board, and show cause why said work or improvement should not be carried out in accordance with this resolution.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this resolution twice in the manner required by law, in the Redlands Daily Facts, a daily newspaper published and circulated in said city, hereby designated for that purpose.

The Superintendent of Streets of said city is hereby directed to post notices of the passage of this resolution in the time, form, manner and as required by the said "Improvement Act of 1911."
