Center Ave. Sidewalks
Curbs, gutters - Sidewalks E & S

Resolution Ordering Work to be Done, No. 282

Resolved: That the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands deem it to be required by the public interest and convenience, and hereby orders that the following street work be done, to-wit:

The construction of cement sidewalks upon Center street from the north curb line of Olive avenue to the south curb line of Ladd street produced, excepting where sidewalks are already in to the official grade of said street, all according to the plans, profiles and specifications for said work and as shown on such plans, all on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city.

The Redlands Daily Review, a daily newspaper published and circulated in said city, is hereby designated as the newspaper in which this resolution and notice of said work, inviting sealed proposals, shall be published in the manner and form and by the person required by law.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish a notice of said work, inviting sealed proposals or bids for doing said work, and referring to the specifications posted or on file for two days, in the Redlands Daily Review, a daily newspaper published and circulated in said city, hereby designated for that purpose. Said notice shall require a certified check or a bond, either, as prescribed by law, and for an amount not less than ten per cent of the aggregate of the proposal. He is also directed to post said notice with specifications conspicuously for five days on or near the Council Chamber door.

NOTICE OF AWARD OF CONTRACT NO. 282

Pursuant to the resolution of award of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands adopted on the 17th day of December, 1909, directing this notice, notice is hereby given that the said Board of Trustees, in open session, on said date, opened, examined and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the following street work, to-wit:

The construction of cement sidewalks upon Center street from the north curb line of Olive avenue to the south curb line of Ladd street produced, excepting where sidewalks are already in to the official grade of said street, all according to the plans, profiles and specifications for said work and as shown on such plans, all on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city.

And thereafter, to-wit, on the 17th day of December, 1909, awarded the contract for said work to the lowest regular responsible bidder, to-wit, F. Montigel & Sons, at the prices named for said work in his proposal on file, to-wit: 11½ cents per square foot for all of said work, and that said award has been approved by a three-fourths vote of said Board of Trustees.

NOTICE OF STREET WORK No. 282

Public notice is hereby given that on the 26th day of October, 1909, the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands adopted Resolution of Intention No. 282, to order the following street work to be done, to-wit:

1st. The construction of stone curbs, and cement gutters, and cement sidewalks upon the north side of East State street from Eighth street to Church street, except at street intersections and at places where such curbs, gutters and sidewalks are already in to the official grade of said street, all according to the plans, profiles and specifications for said work and as shown on such plans, all on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city.

That said work is, in the opinion of said Board, of more than local and ordinary public benefit, and the expense of said work is hereby made chargeable upon the district hereinafter specified. That the exterior boundaries of said district hereby established and the exterior boundaries of the lands hereby declared to be benefited by said work and improvement, and to be assessed to pay the costs and expenses thereof, are described as follows:

Beginning at the southwest corner of Lot 2 of Block 18, Town Plat of Redlands; thence north to northwest corner of said lot; thence east to west line of Lot 30 of Arcadia Addition; thence south to northwest corner of Lot 32 of said addition; thence east to west line of Church street; thence south to State street; thence west to place of beginning.

2nd. The construction of cement sidewalks upon Center street from the north curb line of Olive avenue to the south curb line of Ladd street produced, excepting where sidewalks are already in to the official grade of said street, all according to the plans, profiles and specifications for said work and as shown on such plans, all on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city.

Reference is hereby made to said resolution for further particulars.
