## Resolution of Intention No. 272

Resolved, That the public interest and convenience require and that it is the intention of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands to order the following street work to be done, to

the intention of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands to order the following street work to be done, to wit:

First. That the roadway of East State Street from the end of the asphalt thereon near Seventh street to the macadam work on Church street, including all intersections of said street (except such portions thereof as are required by law to be kept in order or repair by any person or company having railroad tracks thereon, and excepting the gutterways upon said East State street) shall be macadamized with crushed rock base, coated with liquid asphalt wearing surface all in accordance with and as shown on plans, profile, and cross-sections and specifiations therefor on file in the office of the City Enginer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made; and one re-inforced concrete arched culvert near Ninth street shall be constructed in accordance with and where shown on plans, cross-sections and specifications therefor on file in said Engineer's office to which reference is hereby made.

The Board of Trustees of said City hereby finds upon estimates of the City Engineer that the total cost of said improvements and street work will be greater than fifty cents per front foot along each line of said street, including the cost of intersection work assessable upon said frontage, and it is hereby determined in pursuance of an Act of the Legislature of the State of California, approved February 27, 1893, and Acts amendatory thereto, that bonds shall be issued to represent the cost of said improvements and street work. Said bonds shall be issued in manner and form as provided by law; an even annual proportion of the principal sum thereof shall be payable by coupons on the second day of January of each year after their date until the whole is paid, and said bonds shall be ar interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum on all sums unpaid, until the whole of said principal and interest are paid. Said interest shall be payable semi-annually on the second days of January and July, respectively,

Second. That the roadway of West State street from the asphalt on Third street intersection to the east curb line produced on First street, including all intersections of streets (except such portions thereof as are required by law to be kept in order or repair by any person or company having railroad thacks thereon) for a width of twelve (12) feet on either side of a line four and one-half feet distant from and parallel with the center line of the railroad track thereon, shall be macadmized with crushed rock base, coated with liquid asphalt wearing surface, and the balance of the roadway between said points upon said street shall be graded and olled and all in accordance with plans, profiles, cross-section and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city to all of which reference is hereby made.

Third That the roadway of Seventh street including all intersections of streets, for a width of ten feet on either side of the center line of said street, from the north line of Citrus Avenue to the macadam work on Stuart avenue, (except such portions of such street intersections already macadamized and such portions of said Seventh street as are required.

of such street intersections already macadamized and such portions of said Seventh street as are required by law to be kept in order or repair by any person or company having ailroad tracks theron,) shall be nacadamized with crushed rock base, coated with liquid asphalt wearing urface, all in accordance with plans.
