RESOLUTION OF DERING WORK TO BE DONE.

Resolved that the board of trustees of the city of Redlands deem it to be required by the public interest and convenience, and hereby exters that the following street work be done, to wit:-

Ist. That the roadway of Bast and West Central avenue in said city from the east curb lines of Fourth street, to the east line of Fifth street, including all intersections of streets (excepting 27 inches in width from the curb line on each side of said East and West Central avenue, along the gutter way thereof, and excepting such portions of said street and intersections as have already been paved) shall be paved with asphaltic cement and broken stone base, with asphalt wearing surface, in accordance with plans, profile and cross-sections therefor on file in the effice of the City Engineer, and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer, and specifications cach side of said East and West Central avenue, to be paved as aforesaid, for a width of 27 inches from the curb lines of said street, shall be grouted and surfaced with cement (excepting where already grouted or surfaced with cement) in accordance with plans, profile and cross-section therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer, and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer, and specifications therefor
