

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 80.

Resolution of the board of trustees of the city of Redlands declaring its intention to improve a portion of East and West Central Avenues.

The board of trustees of said the city of Redlands do ordain as follows:-

Section 1. That the public interest and convenience require and that it is the intention of the board of trustees of said city to order the following street work to be done, to wit:-

let:- That the roadway of East and West Central Avenue in said city from the east curb line of Fourth St., to the east line of Fifth St., including all intersections of streets (excepting ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~
~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ 87 inches in width
on each side of the curb line of said East and West Central Ave. along the gutter way thereof, and excepting such portions of said street and intersections as have already been paved) shall be paved with asphaltic cement and broken stone base, with asphalt wearing surface, in accordance with plans,

profile and cross-sections therefor on file in the office of the city engineer, and specifications therefor on file in the office of the city clerk.

And:- That all cobble stone gutters along each side of said avenue ^{for a width of 27 inches from the curb line of each street, shall} East and West Central Ave., to be paved as afore said, ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ be grouted and surfaced with ^{Cement} ~~concrete~~ (excepting where already grouted or and surfaced with ^{Cement} ~~concrete~~ with a smooth and undisturbed surface) in accordance with plans, profile and cross-section and specifications ~~therefor to be hereafter prepared by said city engineer.~~

therefor on file in the office of the city engineer, and specifications therefor on file in the office of the city clerk.

Section 2. The street superintendent shall post notice of this work and the passage of this resolution, as required by law, and shall cause a similar notice to be published for six days, in the manner required by law, in the Redlands Daily Facts, hereby designated for that purpose.

Section 3. The city clerk shall certify to the passage of this resolution and shall cause the same to be published by two insertions as required by law, in the Citrograph, a weekly newspaper, hereby designated for that purpose, and shall post the same for two days on or near the chamber door of this board.

RESOLUTION ORDERING WORK TO BE DONE.

(No. 209)

Resolved that the board of trustees of the city of Redlands deem it to be required by the public interest and convenience, and hereby orders that the following street work be done, to wit:-

1st. That the roadway of East and West Central avenue in said city from the east curb lines of Fourth street, to the east line of Fifth street, including all intersections of streets (excepting 27 inches in width from the curb line on each side of said East and West Central avenue, along the gutter way thereof, and excepting such portions of said street and intersections as have already been paved) shall be paved with asphaltic cement and broken stone base, with asphalt wearing surface, in accordance with plans, profile and cross-sections therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer, and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Clerk.

2nd. That all cobble stone gutters along each side of said East and West Central avenue, to be paved as aforesaid, for a width of 27 inches from the curb lines of said street, shall be grouted and surfaced with cement (excepting where already grouted or surfaced with cement) in accordance with plans, profile and cross-section therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer, and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Clerk.

The city clerk is hereby directed to publish a notice of said work, inviting sealed proposals or bids for doing said work, and referring to the specifications posted or on file for two days, in the manner required by law, in The Citrograph, a weekly newspaper of general circulation and published and circulated in ~~that~~ said city, hereby designated for that purpose. Said notice shall require a certified check or bond, either, as prescribed by law, and for an amount not less than ten per cent. of the aggregate of the proposal. He is also directed to post said notice with specifications conspicuously for five days on or near the chamber door of said board, and he shall also cause this resolution to be published for two days, in the manner required by law, in said Citrograph, hereby designated for that purpose.
