

Curbs and gutters - Glenwood Drive

**RESOLUTION OF
INTENTION**

No. 351.

(Glenwood Drive and portion Buena Vista Street.)

Resolved, That the public interest and convenience require, and that it is the intention of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands to order the following street work to be done, and improvement to be made, to-wit:

(a) The construction of cement concrete curbs and gutters upon the north side of Glenwood Drive in the city of Redlands between the east curb and gutter line on Center street and connecting therewith, and the east curb and gutter line on Parkwood Drive and connecting therewith, except where already constructed to official grade of said Drive.

(b) The construction of cement concrete curbs and gutters upon the south side of Glenwood Drive in said city, between the east curb and gutter line on Center street and connecting therewith, and the west curb and gutter line on Parkwood Drive, and connecting therewith, and the construction of a cement sidewalk upon the south side of said Glenwood Drive from the east side of said Center street to the west side of said Parkwood Drive, except where already constructed to the official grade of said Drive.

(c) The construction of cement concrete curb and gutter upon the East side of Buena Vista Street from the north curb and gutter line of Glenwood Drive in said city to the south curb and gutter line of Brookside Avenue.

All of said work shall be in accordance with the plans, specifications, profile and cross-sections there-

for, heretofore adopted for doing said work, and now on file in the office of the city engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made, and as shown upon such plans.

Said Board also determines and declares that serial bonds shall be issued to represent each assessment for \$25.00 or more, remaining unpaid for the time, and as provided by law, to represent the expenses of said work and improvement. Said serial bonds shall extend over a period of nine years from the second day of January, next succeeding their date, and an even annual proportion of the principal sum thereof shall be payable by coupon on the second day of January, every year, after their date, until the whole is paid; and the interest shall be payable semi-annually by coupons, on the second days of January and July, respectively, of each year, at the rate of seven per cent annum, on all sums unpaid, until the whole of said principal and interest are paid. Said bonds shall be issued in the form and manner and as required by the Improvement Act of 1911, so-called.

Notice is hereby given that on the 6th day of June, 1923, at 2 o'clock p. m., in the Council Chamber of said Board, any and all persons having any objections to the proposed work or improvement, may appear before said Board, and show cause why said work or improvement should not be carried out in accordance with this resolution.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this resolution twice in the manner required by law, in the Redlands Daily Facts, a daily newspaper published and circulated in said city, hereby designated for that purpose.

The Superintendent of Streets of said city is hereby directed to post notice of the passage of this resolution in the time, manner and as required by law.

**NOTICE INVITING
SEALED PROPOSALS**

(Glenwood Drive)

Pursuant to statute and resolution of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, adopted on the 20th day of June, 1923, directing this notice, the undersigned invites and will receive at his office, in said City, up to two o'clock p. m. on the 18th day of July, 1923, sealed proposals or bids, for the following street work, to be done according to specifications therefor, posted and on file, adopted for said work, as herein mentioned, to-wit:

(a) The construction of cement concrete curbs and gutters upon the north side of Glenwood Drive in the city of Redlands between the east curb and gutter line on Center street and connecting therewith, and the east curb and gutter line on Parkwood Drive and connecting therewith, except where already constructed to official grade of said Drive.

(b) The construction of cement concrete curbs and gutters upon the south side of Glenwood Drive in said city, between the east curb and gutter line on Center street and connecting therewith, and the west curb and gutter line on Parkwood Drive, and connecting therewith, and the construction of a cement sidewalk upon the south side of said Glenwood Drive from the east side of said Center street to the west side of said Parkwood Drive, except where already constructed to the official grade of said Drive.

All of said work shall be in accordance with the plans, specifications, profile and cross-sections therefor, heretofore adopted for doing said work, and now on file in the office of the city engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made, and as shown upon such plans.

Said Board also determines and declares that serial bonds shall be issued to represent each assessment for \$25.00 or more, remaining unpaid for the time, and as provided by law, to represent the expenses of said work and improvement. Said serial bonds shall extend over a period of nine years from the second day of January, next succeeding their date, and an even annual proportion of the principal sum thereof shall be payable by coupon on the second day of January, every year, after their date, until the whole is paid; and the interest shall be payable semi-annually by coupons, on the second days of January and July, respectively, of each year, at the rate of seven per cent annum, on all sums unpaid, until the whole of said principal and interest are paid. Bidders must file with each proposal or bid, a check payable to said City, certified by a responsible bank, for an amount which shall not be less than ten per cent of the aggregate of the proposal, or a bond for the said amount, and so payable, signed by the bidder and two sureties, who shall justify before any officer competent to administer an oath, in double the said amount, and over and above all statutory exemptions.

Bids will be opened on the 18th day of July, 1923, at 2 o'clock, p. m., and if a contract for said work be not then awarded, further bids will be received at any subsequent meeting of said Board until a contract therefor shall be awarded.

Pursuant to the resolution of award of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, adopted on the 18th day of July, 1923, directing this notice, notice is hereby given that the said Board of Trustees, in open session, on said date, opened, examined and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the following street work, to-wit:

(a) The construction of cement concrete curbs and gutters upon the north side of Glenwood Drive in the city of Redlands between the east curb and gutter line on Center street and connecting therewith, and the east curb and gutter line on Parkwood Drive and connecting therewith, except where already constructed to official grade of said Drive.
