

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 225.

Resolved, by the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands that it is the intention of said Board to order the following street work to be done in said City, to wit:

The west extension of that certain street in said city known as Home Place.

That the land which is by said Board deemed necessary to be taken therefor, and which this Board intends to take therefor, is described as follows, to wit:

All that certain land lying and situated in said city, San Bernardino County, State of California, described as follows: Beginning at the most easterly corner of lot 33 of the Excelsior Tract, according to a map thereof of record in the office of the County Recorder of said county in Book 5 of Maps, page 40, thence southwesterly^{along} the northwesterly boundary line of lot 2 of block I of the Second Preliminary Map of Redlands, according to a map thereof of record in said Recorder's office, to the most westerly corner of said lot 2; thence northwesterly along the northeasterly boundary line of lot 6 of said block I, 30 feet, thence northeasterly *and* parallel with the said northwesterly boundary line of said lot 2, to the most northerly corner of said lot 33 in said Excelsior Tract, thence southeasterly to the place of beginning.

That the exterior boundaries of the district hereby established, and the exterior boundaries of the district of lands hereby declared to be affected and benefitted by said work or improvement, and to be assessed to pay the damages, cost and expenses thereof, are described as follows:

Beginning at the most northerly corner of lot 33 of said Excelsior Tract, thence northwesterly to the most northerly corner of lot 25 of said tract; thence southwesterly to the most westerly corner of said lot 25, thence southeasterly to the most northerly corner of lot 12 of the Loma Vista Tract; thence southwesterly to the northeasterly boundary line of said lot 6 in block I of the second Preliminary Map of Redlands aforesaid, thence northwesterly to the most northerly corner of said lot 6; thence southwesterly to the most westerly corner of said lot 6; thence southeasterly to the most northerly corner of lot 5-1/4 of block J of Redlands, according to a map of Addition No. 5 of Redlands, recorded in said Recorder's office in Book 5 of Maps, page 7; thence southwesterly along the northwesterly boundary line of said lot 5-1/4 and lot 5 of said block J, to Center Street; thence southeasterly to the most southerly corner of said lot 5; thence northeasterly to the most easterly corner of said lot 5-1/4; thence southeasterly to the most northerly corner of lot 4-1/2 of said block J; thence southwesterly to the most westerly corner of lot 4-3/4 of said block J; thence southeasterly to the most southerly corner of said lot 4-3/4; thence northeasterly to the most easterly corner of said lot 4-1/2; thence southeasterly to the most southerly corner of lot 3 in said block I of the Second Preliminary Map of Redlands; thence northeasterly to the most easterly corner of lot 21 of the Park Villa Tract, according to a map thereof of record in said Recorder's office; thence northwesterly to the most easterly corner of said lot 33 of said Excelsior Tract; thence southwesterly to the most easterly corner of said lot 6^{said} in block I of the Second Preliminary Map of Redlands; thence northwesterly along the northeasterly boundary line of said lot 6 in said block I, thirty feet; thence northeasterly and parallel with the said northwesterly boundary line of said lot 2 in said block I to the most northerly corner of said lot 33 in said Excelsior Tract and being the place of beginning.

The Redlands Daily Review, a daily newspaper published and circulated in said city, is hereby designated as the newspaper in which the Street Superintendent of said City shall cause to be published, in the manner and form required by law,

notice of the passage of this Resolution, and the said Street Superintendent is hereby directed to cause notices of the passage of this Resolution to be posted in the manner and form required by law, and to cause a notice, similar in substance, to be published in said newspaper for a period of ten days, in the manner required by law.
