

Notice Inviting Sealed
Proposals
No. 440

KENDALL ST.—PAVING, ETC.
Pursuant to Statute and to Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, directing this notice, said Board hereby invites sealed proposals or bids for doing the following work in said City, to-wit:
That the roadway of Kendall Street in said city from the north line of Brookside Avenue to the south line of West State Street produced across said Kendall Street, including the roadway of all street intersections to the property line of Kendall Street produced across such intersections between said points be paved with 4 inch macadam pavement with asphaltic oil wearing surface; also the construction of concrete curbs and gutters on both sides of said Kendall Street between Sacramento Street and West State Street; also the construction of stone curbs and concrete gutters on both sides of said Kendall Street between Brookside Avenue and Sacramento Street where not already constructed; also the repair of the curb on both sides of Kendall Street between said points wherever the capping or face joint has been removed from any cause; also the reconstruction of the gutter on both sides of said Kendall Street from Brookside Avenue to Sacramento Street; also the reconstruction and resetting of the curb wherever out of place or line from any cause on both sides of said Kendall Street between said points; also the removal of all bridges over the gutters and the construction of concrete dip driveways on said Kendall Street between said points where not already constructed; and also the construction of 2, 4-inch vitrified sewer pipe laterals from and connecting with the main sewer on said Kendall Street between Brookside Avenue and Sacramento Street to one foot beyond the curb-line, one lateral to be constructed to each lot or parcel of land where a sewer lateral has not already been constructed, all as shown on plans.

Said contemplated work and improvement is, in the opinion of said Board of more than local or ordinary public benefit and therefore the expense of said work and improvement is hereby made chargeable upon the district described as follows, to-wit:
Beginning at a point on the northerly line of Brookside Avenue 75 feet easterly from the easterly line of Kendall Street; thence 75 feet from and parallel with the easterly line of Kendall Street northerly to the southerly line of Lot 13, Lord's Subdivision, Book 14 of Maps, page 10, San Bernardino County Records; thence to the southeast corner of said lot 13; thence along the easterly line of Lord's Subdivision to the northeast corner of Lot 19 of said subdivision; thence to the southeast corner of Lot 15, Block A, Peller, Pratt and Kendall Subdivision, Book 5 of Maps, page 22, San Bernardino County Records; thence north 50 feet from and parallel with the east line of Kendall Street to the south line of West State Street; thence along the south line of West State Street to a point 53 feet west of the west line of Kendall Street; thence to the southwest corner of Lot 12, Block B, of said Peller, Pratt and Kendall Subdivision; thence to the northwest corner of Lot 4, Lord's Subdivision; thence along the westerly line of said subdivision to the southwesterly corner of Lot 12 of said subdivision; thence along the southerly line of said Lot 12 easterly to a point 73 feet westerly of the westerly line of Kendall Street; thence southerly 73 feet from and parallel with the westerly line of Kendall Street to the northerly line of Brookside Avenue; thence easterly along the northerly line of Brookside Avenue to the point of beginning.

All of said work mentioned shall be done and improvement made upon the grade, along the lines, between the points, of the dimensions, at the place and in the manner and as shown upon and according to the plans, profiles and detail drawings for said work and according to the specifications therefor, which said plans, profiles, detail drawings and specifications have heretofore been adopted by said board for doing said work and are now on file in the office of the city engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

The said Board of Trustees also determines and declares that serial bonds bearing interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum shall be issued to represent each assessment of \$25.00 or more remaining unpaid for twenty days after the date of the warrant as to said work.

Said serial bonds shall extend over a period of nine years from the second day of January next succeeding the 15th day of the Next November following their date. Payments on the principal of unpaid assessments and interest shall be made by property owners to the City Treasurer and the same shall be disbursed by him, all as provided in and by the Improvement Act of 1911, so-called. The principal and interest of said bonds shall be payable in the manner and as provided by said Act.
