That the roadway of Pearl Avenue, in said city, between the gutter lines thereof, from the east line of Orange street to the east line of the 14th street, according to a map of said tract, recorded in the office of the county recorder of San Bernardino County, California, including the roadway of Sixth Street intersection between the gutter lines thereof (produced as said Sixth street) except where already paved with macadam, be paved with four inch macadam pavement, with asphaltic wearing surface, to the official grade thereof, and also that the curbs and concrete gutters on both sides of said Pearl Avenue, between said points, be constructed thereon, excepting where already constructed to the official grade and excepting to the roadway of alley and street intersections between said points and all where and as at the points and places shown on the plans for said work.

Item 2. That certain sidewalks be constructed on said Pearl Avenue between the east line of Orange street and the west curb line of Sixth street, on both sides of said Pearl Avenue, where not already constructed thereon to the official grade thereof.

Item 3. That the roadway of Buena Vista Street between the curb lines thereof, from and connecting with the eastward movement on Brooklyn Avenue in said city to the north curb line of Fern Vista Street across said Fern Vista Street, including the roadway of all street intersections, excepting that portion of Olive Avenue already paved with macadam and excepting that portion of a twelve foot alleyway between the gutter lines produced across said alley and the property lines produced across said alley, be saved with four inch macadam pavement, with automatic manholes, and also that a stone curb be constructed in the westerly side of said Buena Vista Street from the northwesterly corner line of Glenwood Drive, produced across said Drive to the westerly property line of Beekmille Avenue, produced across said Avenue, and also that concrete pillars be constructed upon said Buena Vista Street, between the posts where said pavement is to be constructed as indicated, at the public and places where shown upon the plans hereto.

The said Board of Trustees also determine and declare that certain bonds bearing interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum shall be issued to represent each assessment of \$25.00 or more remaining unpaid for twenty days after the date of the warrant as to each of said respective item of work. The said bonds shall extend over a period of nine years, terminating on the second day of January next, commencing the 15th day of November, 1924, and running until and following their date. Payments made in the principal of unsold assessments and interest shall be made by the property owners to the City Treasurer and the same shall be delivered by him as so provided to and by the Improvement Act of 1911 so-called.

(Item 3—Buena Vista Street, between Brookside Avenue and Fern Avenue)

Pursuant to Statute and to Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, directing this notice, said Board hereby invites sealed proposals or bids for doing the following work in said City, to-wit:

Item 3. That the roadway of Buena Vista Street between the curb lines thereof, from and connecting with the macadam pavement on Brookside Avenue in said city to the north curb line of Fern Avenue (produced), across said Buena Vista Street, including the roadway of all street intersections, excepting that portion of Olive Avenue already paved with macadam and excepting that portion of a twelve foot alleyway between said alley and the property lines produced across said alley, be repaved with asphalt wearing surface, to the office grade thereof, and also that a signa curb be constructed on the easterly side of said Buena Vista Street from the northerly property line of Glenwood Drive, produced across said Drive, to the southerly property line of Brookside Avenue, produced across said Avenue, and also that concrete gutters be constructed upon said Buena Vista street between the points where said pavement is to be constructed as aforesaid, at the points and places and as and where shown upon the plans thereof.

All of said work shall be done in accordance with the plans, profiles, detail drawings and specifications therefor, heretofore adopted for doing said work and now on file in the office of the City Engineer of said City to all of which reference is hereby made.

Said contemplated work and improvement, as to each of said respective items of work is, in the opinion of said Board, of more than local or ordinary public benefit and therefore the expense of each such item of said work and improvement is hereby made chargeable upon the respective district hereinafter specified; that the exterior boundaries of each of said respective districts hereby established and declared to be benefitted by each such item of work and improvement and to be assessed to pay the cost and expense thereof is indicated and shown by a brown boundary line surrounding each such district and lands declared benefitted by each such item of work and improvement are shown and indicated by the boundaries and extent of the territory included in each such district upon a separate plat showing the lands embraced within each such district and being marked "Assessment District," being the assessment district for each of said respective items of said work and improvement and being on file in the office of said City Engineer to which respective plans reference is hereby made.

The said Board of Trustees also determines and declares that serial bonds bearing interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum shall be issued to represent each assessment of \$25.00 or more remaining unpaid to twenty days after the date of the warrant as to each of said respective items of work.

Said serial bonds shall extend over a period of nine years from the second day of January next succeeding the 15th day of November following their date. Payments on the principal of unpaid assessments and interest shall be made by the property owners to the City Treasurer and the same shall be disbursed by him, all as provided in the improvement act of 1911, so-called.

Reference is hereby made to Resolution No. 367 of said city declaring its intention to order said work to be done, for further particulars, which Resolution is on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City, and reference is hereby further made to the specifications for said work posted and on file.

All proposals or bids shall be accompanied by a check payable to the City of Portland, certified by a responsible bank for an amount which shall not be less than ten per cent of the aggregate of the proposal or by a bond for the said amount and so payable signed by the bidder and two sureties, who shall justify before any officer competent to administer an oath, in double the said amount, a power and above all statutory emp-

Said proposals of bids shall be delivered to the Clerk of said City on or before two o'clock p. m., on the 1st day of January, 1935, and be a contract for said work will be then awarded, further bids will be received at any subsequent meeting of said Board until a contract therefor shall be awarded.
