Notice Inviting Sealed
Proposals
No. 409

(Improve Post St.)
Pursuant to Statute and to Reso-
lution of the Board of Trustees of
the City of Redlands, directing this
notice, said Board hereby invites
sealed proposals or bids for doing
the following work in said City, to-
wit:

That a cement sidewalk 5 feet
in width be constructed on the
west side of Post Street in said
city; and also the construction of
stone curbs and concrete gutters
on both sides of Post Street where
not already constructed.

All of said work mentioned shall
be done and improvement made
upon the grade, along the lines,
between the points, of the dimen-
sions, at the place, and in the
manner and as shown upon and ac-
cording to the plans, profiles and
detail drawings for said work and
according to the specifications there-
for, which said plans, profiles, de-
tail drawings and specifications have
heretofore been adopted by said
board for doing said work and are
now on file in the office of the
city engineer of said city, to all
of which reference is hereby made.

Said contemplated work and im-
provement is, in the opinion of said
Board, of more than local or or-
dinary public benefit and therefore
the expense of said work and im-
provement is hereby made chargea-
ble upon the district described as
follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the North
line of Cotton Avenue 150 feet east
of the east line of Post Street;
thence North 150 feet from and
parallel with the east line of Post
Street to a point on the North line
of the Casa Loma Addition pro-
duced east; thence west along said
line to a point 135 feet west of the
west line of Post Street; thence
south 135 feet from and parallel
with the west line of Post Street
to the North line of Lot 4 of said
Casa Loma Addition; thence east
along the North line of Lot 4 and
Lot 5 of said Casa Loma Addition
to the Northeast corner of said Lot
5; thence South along the East
line of said Lot 5 to the North line
of Cotton Avenue; thence east to the
point of beginning.

The said Board of Trustees also
determines and declares that serial
bonds bearing interest at the rate
of seven per cent per annum shall
be issued to represent each assess-
ment of \$25.00 or more remaining
unpaid for twenty days after the
date of the warrant as to said work.

Said serial bonds shall extend over
a period of nine years from the
second day of January next suc-
ceeding the 15th day of the next
November following their date. Pay-
ments on the principal and unpaid
assessments and interest shall be
made by property owners to the
City Treasurer and the same shall
be disbursed by him, all as pro-
vided in and by the Improvement
Act of 1911, so-called. The prin-
cipal and interest of said bonds
shall be payable in the manner and
as provided by said Act.

Reference is hereby made to Reso-
lution of Intention No. 409 of said
City, declaring its intention to order
said work to be done, for further
particulars, which Resolution is on
file in the office of the City Clerk
of said City, and reference is here-
by further made to the specifications
for said work posted and on file.

All proposals or bids shall be ac-
companied by a check payable to
the City of Redlands, certified by a
responsible bank for an amount
which shall not be less than ten
per cent of the aggregate of the
proposal, or by a bond for the said
amount and so payable, signed by
the bidder and two sureties, who
shall justify, before any officer com-
petent to administer an oath, in
double the said amount, and over
and above all statutory exemptions.

Said proposals or bids shall be de-
livered to the Clerk of said City,
on or before two o'clock P. M., on
the 3rd day of February, 1926, and
if a contract for said work be not
then awarded, further bids will be
received at any subsequent meeting
of said Board until a contract there-
for shall be awarded.
