**Resolution Ordering
Work To Be Done
No. 274**

(Reservoir Street.)

Resolved: That the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands deem it to be required by the public interest and convenience, and hereby orders that the following street work be done, to-wit:

That the roadway of Reservoir street from the macadam work upon Citrus Avenue to the north curb line of Highland Avenue be improved by having the following street work done thereon, to-wit:

That the roadway of said Reservoir Street from the macadam work upon Citrus Avenue to the south line of New Avenue produced to the west line of Reservoir Street, including all intersections of streets, for a width of twenty feet, and from the south line of New Avenue, produced to the west line of Reservoir Street to the north curb line of Highland Avenue including all intersection of streets for a width of nineteen feet, shall all be macadamized with crushed rock base coated with liquid asphalt wearing surface, all to be done as shown upon and in accordance with plans, profiles, cross-sections and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

All of said macadam work shall begin at the east gutter line of said Reservoir street between said points.

The Redlands Daily Facts, a daily newspaper published and circulated in said city, is hereby designated as the newspaper in which this resolution and notice of said work, inviting sealed proposals, shall be published in the manner and form and by the person required by law.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish a notice of said work, inviting sealed proposals or bids for doing said work, and referring to the specifications posted or on file for two days, in the Redlands Daily Facts, a daily newspaper published and circulated in said city, hereby designated for that purpose. Said notice shall require a certified check or a bond, either, as prescribed by law, and for an amount not less than ten per cent of the aggregate of the proposal. He is also directed to post said notice with specifications conspicuously for five days on or near the Council Chamber door.

(Reservoir Street.)

Public notice is hereby given that on the 6th day of January, 1909, the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands adopted Resolution of Intention No. 274 to order the following street work to be done, to-wit:

That the roadway of Reservoir street from the macadam work upon Citrus Avenue to the north curb line of Highland Avenue be improved by having the following street work done thereon, to-wit:

That the roadway of said Reservoir Street from the macadam work upon Citrus Avenue to the south line of New Avenue produced to the west line of Reservoir Street, including all intersections of streets, for a width of twenty feet, and from the south line of New Avenue, produced to the west line of Reservoir Street to the north curb line of Highland Avenue including all intersection of streets for a width of nineteen feet, shall all be macadamized with crushed rock base coated with liquid asphalt wearing surface, all to be done as shown upon and in accordance with plans, profiles, cross-sections and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

of Award of Contract
No. 274
Reservoir street.**

Pursuant to the resolution of award of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands adopted on the 3rd day of March, 1909, directing this notice, notice is hereby given that the said Board of Trustees, in open session, said date, opened, examined and publicly declared all sealed proposals bids offered for the following street work, to-wit:

That the roadway of Reservoir street from the macadam work upon Citrus Avenue to the north curb line of Highland Avenue be improved by having the following street work done thereon, to-wit:

That the roadway of said Reservoir street from the macadam work upon Citrus Avenue to the south line of New Avenue produced to the west line of Reservoir street, including all intersections of streets, for a width of twenty feet, and from the south line of New Avenue, produced to the west line of Reservoir street to the north curb line of Highland Avenue, including all intersections of streets for a width of nineteen feet, shall all be macadamized with crushed rock base coated with liquid asphalt wearing surface, all to be done as shown upon and in accordance with plans, profiles, cross-sections and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

All of said macadam work shall begin at the east gutter line of said Reservoir street between said points.

And thereafter, to-wit, on the 6th day of March, 1909, awarded the contract for said work to the lowest regular responsible bidder, to-wit, Ern Frenzell, at the prices named for said work in his proposal on file, to-wit, \$0.74 cents per square foot for all said work, and that said award has been approved by a three-fourths vote of said Board of Trustees.
