That the roadway of Reservoir street from the macadam work upon Citrus Avenue to the north curb line of Highland Avenue be improved by having the following street work done

thereon, to-wit:

That the roadway of said Reservoir Street from the macadam work upon Citrus Avenue to the south line of New Avenue produced to the west line of Reservoir Street, including all in-tersections of streets, for a width of twenty feet, and from the south line of New Avenue, produced to the west fline of Reservoir Street to the north curb line of Highland Avenue includling all interesection of streets for a width of nineteen feet, shall all be macadamized with crushed rock base located with liquid asphalt wearing surface, all to be done as shown upon and in accordance with plans, profiles, cross-sections and specifications therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

All of said macadam work shall begin at the east gutter line of said Reservoir street between said points.

The Redlands Daily Facts, a daily

newspaper published and circulated in said city, is hereby designated as the newspaper in which this resolution and notice of said work, inviting sealed proposals, shall be published in the manner and form and by the person

required by law.
The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish a notice of said work, inviting sealed proposals or bids for doing said work, and referring to the specifications posted or on file for two days, in the Redlands Daily Facts, a daily newspaper published and circulated in said city, hereby designated for that purpose. Said notice shall require a certified check or a bond, either, as prescribed by law, and for an amount not less than ten per cent of the appreciate of the a for that purpose. of the aggregate of the proposal. He is also directed to post said notice with specifications conspicuously for five days on or near the Council Chamber door.
