

Resolution of Intention No404 Cement Sidewalk on E. Fern Ave.

Notice Inviting Sealed Proposals No. 404

(For E. Fern Ave., sidewalks.)
Pursuant to Statute and to Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, directing notice, said Board hereby invites sealed proposals or bids for doing the following work in said City, to-wit:

That a cement sidewalk 6 feet wide be constructed on the southerly side of Fern Avenue in said City from the southerly curbline of Beacon Street to and connect with a sidewalk already constructed approximately 1900 feet west from the southerly curbline of Beacon Street.

All of said work mentioned shall be done and improvement made on the grade, along the lines, between the points, of the dimensions at the places and in the manner and as shown upon and according to the plans, profiles and drawings for said work and according to the specifications therefor, which said plans, profiles, and drawings and specifications have heretofore been adopted by said Board for doing said work and now on file in the office of the City Engineer of said City, to all of which reference is hereby made.

Said contemplated work and improvement is, in the opinion of said Board, of more than local or ordinary public benefit and therefore the expense of said work and improvement is hereby made chargeable upon the district described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the intersection of Fern Avenue and Beacon Street; thence westerly along the center line of Fern Avenue to a point on the center line of Lot Block F, Second Preliminary Map of Redlands, produced north to center of Fern Avenue; thence southerly along said center line of said Lot 6 to a point 192 feet southerly from the southerly line of Fern Avenue; thence easterly parallel with and 192 feet from the southerly line of Fern Avenue to the easterly line of Lot 7 of said Block F; thence northerly along the easterly line of said Lot 7 to the northeasterly corner thereof; thence to the point beginning.

The said Board of Trustees determines and declares that said bonds bearing interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum shall be issued to represent each assessment of \$25.00 or more remain unpaid for twenty days after date of the warrant as to each said respective item of work.

Said serial bonds shall be tendered over a period of nine years from the second day of January next succeeding the 15th day of the next November following their date. Payments on the principal of said assessments and interest shall be made by property owners to the City Treasurer and the same shall be disbursed by him, all as provided in and by the Improvement Act of 1911, so-called. The principal and interest of said bonds shall be payable in the manner and as provided by said Act.

Reference is hereby made to Resolution of Intention No. 404 of said City, declaring its intention to do said work to be done, for further particulars, which Resolution is on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City, and reference is hereby further made to the specifications for said work posted and on file.

All proposals or bids shall be accompanied by a check payable to the City of Redlands, certified by a responsible bank for an amount which shall not be less than ten per cent of the aggregate of the proposal, or by a bond for the same amount and so payable, signed by the bidder and two sureties, who shall justify, before any officer competent to administer an oath, double the said amount, and one and above all statutory exemptions.

Said proposals or bids shall be delivered to the Clerk of said City on or before two o'clock P. M. on the 6th day of January, 1926, and if a contract for said work is not then awarded, further bids shall be received at any subsequent meeting of said Board until a contract therefor shall be awarded.
