

Notice Inviting Sealed
Proposals., No. 425

(Stillman Avenue Improvement)
Pursuant to Statute and to Reso-
lution of the Board of Trustees of
the City of Redlands, directing this
notice, said Board hereby invites
sealed proposals or bids for doing
the following work in said City, to-
wit:

That the roadway of Stillman Ave-
nue in said city between the gut-
ters thereon be paved with 4 inch
macadam pavement with asphaltic
oil wearing surface from and con-
necting with the macadam pave-
ment on Church Street to the west
gutter line of Chapel Street produced
across said Stillman Avenue, includ-
ing the roadway of all street inter-
sections to the property line of
Stillman Avenue produced across
such intersections between said
points; also the reconstruction of
gutters on both sides of Stillman
Avenue from Division Street to
Church Street; also the construction
of stone curbs on both sides of Still-
man Avenue where not already con-
structed; also the repair of the curb
on said street wherever the capping
or face joint has been removed from
any cause; also the removal of all
bridges over the gutters and the
construction of concrete dip drive-
ways between the gutters and side-
walks at all private driveways and
alleyways on said street.

Said contemplated work and im-
provement is, in the opinion of said
Board, of more than local or ordinary
public benefit and therefore the ex-
pense of said work and improvement
is hereby made chargeable upon the
district described as follows, to-wit:
Beginning at the northwest corner
of Lot 7, Block 1, Lugonia Heights;
thence east to the northeast corner
of said Lot 7; thence northerly to
the northwest corner of Lot 1 of
Revised Map of Part of Block 4 of
Lugonia Heights; thence east to the
northeast corner of Lot 28, Block 4,
Lugonia Heights; thence easterly to
the northwest corner of Lot 9, Block
7, Lugonia Heights; thence east to
the northeast corner of Lot 16 of
said Block 7; thence south to the
southeast corner of Lot 1, Block 3,
Lugonia Heights; thence west to the
southwest corner of Lot 14, Block 5,
Lugonia Heights; thence northerly
to the southeast corner of Lot 1,
Block 2, Lugonia Heights; thence
west to the southwest corner of
said Lot 1; thence north to the
point of beginning.

All of said work mentioned shall
be done and improvement made upon
the grade, along the lines, between
the points, of the dimensions, at the
place and in the manner and as
shown upon and according to the
plans, profiles and detail drawings
for said work and according to the
specifications therefor, which said
plans, profiles, detail drawings, and
specifications have heretofore been
adopted by said board for doing said
work and are now on file in the
office of the city engineer of said
city, to all of which reference is
hereby made.

The said Board of Trustees also de-
termines and declares that serial
bonds bearing interest at the rate
of seven per cent per annum shall
be issued to represent each assess-
ment of \$25.00 or more remaining un-
paid for twenty days after the date
of the warrant as to said work.
Said serial bonds shall extend over
a period of nine years from the sec-
ond day of January next succeeding
the 15th day of the Next November
following their date. Payments on

Improvement shall be made as follows:
The principal and interest of said
bonds shall be payable in the man-
ner and as provided by said Act.
Reference is hereby made to
Resolution of Intention No. 425 of
said City, declaring its intention to
order said work to be done, for fur-
ther particulars, which Resolution is
on file in the office of the City
Clerk of said City, and reference is
hereby further made to the speci-
fications for said work posted and on
file.

All proposals or bids shall be ac-
companied by a check payable to
the City of Redlands, certified by a
responsible bank for an amount
which shall not be less than ten
per cent of the aggregate of the
proposal, or by a bond for the said
amount and so payable, signed by
the bidder and two sureties, who
shall justify, before any officer
competent to administer an oath, in
double the said amount, and over
and above all statutory exemptions.
Said proposals or bids shall be de-
livered to the Clerk of said City, on
or before two o'clock P. M., on the
1st day of September, 1926, and if a
contract for said work be not then
awarded, further bids will be re-
ceived at any subsequent meeting of
said Board until a contract therefor
shall be awarded.

(Stillman Ave. Macadam, curb and
gutter repair)

RESOLVED, That the public inter-
est and convenience require, and that
it is the intention of the Board of
Trustees of the City of Redlands
to order the following work to be
done, and improvement to be made,
to-wit:

That the roadway of Stillman Ave-
nue in said city between the gut-

southwest corner of Lot 14, Block 5,

Block 2, Lugonia Heights; thence
west to the southwest corner of
said Lot 1; thence north to the
point of beginning.

p. m., in the Council Chamber of
said Board, any and all persons hav-
ing any objections to the proposed
work or improvement may appear
before said Board, and show cause
why said work or improvement
should not be carried out in accord-
ance with this resolution.

The City Clerk is hereby directed
to publish this resolution twice in
the manner required by law, in the
Redlands Daily Facts, a daily news-
paper published and circulated in
said city, hereby designated for that
purpose.

The Superintendent of Streets of
said city is hereby directed to post
notices of the passage of this reso-
lution in the time, form, manner
and as required by the said "Im-
provement Act of 1911."
