## Resolution of Intention No. 451

(Westwood Lane, Mariposa Dr. Gar-  
den Court, Ford St. Imp.)

RESOLVED, That the public inter-  
est and convenience require, and that  
it is the intention of the Board of  
Trustees of the City of Redlands to  
order the following work to be done,  
and improvement to be made to-wit:

That the roadway of Mariposa Drive  
from its intersection with the east-  
erly line of Garden street to the  
easterly line of Westwood Lane, and  
Westwood Lane and Ford Street from  
Garden Street to Garden Court, and  
Garden Court from Ford Street to  
Garden Street in said city be graded,  
oiled and surfaced; also the con-  
struction of concrete curbs and gut-  
ters on both sides of said Mariposa  
Drive and Westwood Lane between  
said points, where not already con-  
structed; also the construction of con-  
crete gutter crossings at all private  
driveways and alleyways, as shown  
on plans; also the construction of a  
concrete cover over the Garden Street  
storm water drain at the intersection  
of Westwood Lane with said storm  
water drain; also the construction of  
a 12-inch corrugated iron culvert  
across Westwood Lane at its inter-  
section with Eucalyptus Drive and at  
its westerly intersection with the  
alleyway thru Westwood Subdivision  
No. 1; also the construction of a 12-  
inch corrugated iron culvert on Mari-  
posa Drive at its intersection with  
Westwood Lane, as shown on plans.

Said contemplated work and im-  
provement is, in the opinion of said  
Board of more than local or ordi-  
nary public benefit and the expense of  
said work and improvement is hereby  
made chargeable upon the district  
hereinafter specified; that the ex-  
terior boundaries of said district here-  
by established and the exterior bound-  
aries of the lands hereby declared  
to be benefitted by said work and im-  
provement and to be assessed to pay  
the cost and expenses thereof are  
described as follows: Beginning at  
the most westerly corner of Lot 1,  
Garden Court Subdivision, Book 20 of  
Maps, page 22, San Bernardino Coun-  
ty Records; thence along the westerly  
and northerly boundaries of said  
Garden Court Subdivision to the  
northeast corner of Lot 8 of said  
Subdivision; thence to the northwest  
corner of Lot 15, Westwood Subdi-  
vision No. 1, Book 22 of Maps, page 13  
and 14, San Bernardino County Rec-  
ords; thence along the northerly line  
of said Lot 15 and the northerly line  
of said Lot 15 produced to its inter-  
section with the westerly line of Lot  
4 of said Subdivision; thence northerly  
and easterly along the westerly and  
northerly line of said Lot 4 and along  
the easterly line of Lots 3, 2 and 1  
of said Westwood Subdivision No. 1  
to the southeast corner of said Lot 1;  
thence westerly along the southerly  
line of said Lot 1, 215.71 feet; thence  
south 5 degrees 20 minutes east 120  
feet; thence westerly 100 feet from  
and parallel with the southerly line of  
Mariposa Drive to the easterly line of  
Garden street; thence westerly along  
the easterly and northerly line of  
Garden street to the point of begin-  
ning.

All of said work mentioned shall be  
done and improvement made upon the  
grade, along the lines, between the  
points, of the dimensions, at the place  
and in the manner and as shown  
upon and according to the plans, pro-  
files and detail drawings for said work  
and according to the specifications  
thereof, which said plans, profiles,  
detail drawings and specifications  
have heretofore been adopted by  
said board for doing said work and  
are now on file in the office of the  
city engineer of said city; to all of  
which reference is hereby made.

The said Board of Trustees also  
determines and declares that serial  
bonds bearing interest at the rate of  
seven per cent per annum shall be  
issued to represent each assessment  
of \$25.00 or more remaining unpaid  
for twenty days after the date of the  
warrant as to said work.

Said serial bonds shall extend over  
a period of nine years from the sec-  
ond day of January next succeeding the  
15th day of the next November follow-  
ing their date. Payments on the prin-  
cipal of unpaid assessments and inter-  
est shall be made by property owners  
to the City Treasurer and the same  
shall be disbursed by him, all as pro-  
vided in and by the Improvement Act  
of 1911, so called. The principal and  
interest of said bonds shall be payable  
in the manner and as provided by  
said Act.

Notice is hereby given that on the  
15th day of June, 1927, at 2 o'clock  
p. m. in the Council Chamber of said  
Board, any and all persons having any  
objections to the proposed work or  
improvement may appear before said  
Board, and show cause why said work  
or improvement should not be carried  
out in accordance with this resolu-  
tion.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to  
publish this resolution twice in the  
manner required by law, in the Red-  
lands Daily Facts, a daily newspaper  
published and circulated in said city,  
hereby designated for that purpose.

The Superintendent of Streets of  
said city is hereby directed to post  
notices of the passage of this resolu-  
tion in the time, form, manner, and  
as required by the said "Improvement  
Act of 1911."

I hereby certify that the foregoing  
resolution was passed by said Board  
of Trustees on May 18th, 1927, at a  
regular meeting thereof, by the un-  
animous vote of said board.
