## Resolution of Intention No. 443

ALLEY PAVEMENT IN BLOCK A, SUB. OF BIK. 28
Resolved. That the public interest and convenience require, and that it is the intention of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands to order the following work to be done and improvement to be made, to-wit:
That the roadway of the alley through Block A, Subdivision of Block 28 of Redlands from the east line of Fifth Street produced across gaid alley to the macadam pavement on Sixth Street be paved with 5 inch Portland cement concrete pavement, where not already paved.
Said contemplated work and improvement is, in the opinion of said Board, of more than local or ordinary public benefit and the expense of said work and improvement is hereby made chargeable upon the district hereinafter specifed; that the exterior boundaries of said district hereby established and the exterior boundaries of said district hereby established and the exterior boundaries of the lands hereby declared to be benefited by said work and improvement and to be assessed to pay the cost and expenses thereof, are described as follows: Beginning at the southerly line of Citrus Avenue to the west line of Sixth Street; thence south along the wes line of Sixth Street to the north line of Vine Street to the east line of Fifth Street; thence south along the wind line of Vine Street to the east line of Fifth Street to the point of beginning.

All of said work mentioned shall be done and improvement made upon the grade, along the lines, between the points, of the dimensions, at the place and in the manner and as shown upon and according to the specifications have herefor, which said plans, profiles detail drawings for said work and according to the specifications have herefore been adopted by said board for doing said work and are now on file in the office of the city engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

The said Board of Trustees also determines and declares that serial bonds beginning interest at the rate of

specifications have beretofore been adopted by said board for doing said work and are now on file in the office of the city engineer of said city, to all of which reference is hereby made.

The said Board of Trustees also determines and declares that serial bonds bearing interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum shall be issued to represent each assessment of twenty days after the date of the warrant as to said work.

Said serial bonds shall extend over a period of nine years from the second day of January next succeeding the 15th day of the Next November following their date. Payments on the principal of unpaid assessments and interest shall be made by property owners to the City Treasurer and the same shall be disbursed by him, all as provided in and by the Imprevement Act of 1911, so-called. The principal and interest of said bonds shall be payable in the manner and as provided by said Act.

Notice is hereby given that on the 20th day of April, 1927, at 2 o'clock b. m. In the Council Chamber of said Board, any and all persons having any objections to the proposed work or improvement should not be carried out in accordance with this resolution.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this resolution twice in the manner required by law, in the Redlands Daily Facts, a daily newspaper published and circulated in said city, hereby designated for that purpose. The Superintendent of Streets of said city is hereby directed to post notices of the passage of this resolution in the time, form, manner and as required by the said "Improvement Act of 1911."
