

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION, NO. 202.

(Widening ~~High~~ Avenue from Orange street to _____ street.)

Resolution of Intention No. 202:-

Resolved, by the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, State of California, as follows, to wit:-

1st:- That it is the intention of said Board of Trustees to order the following street work to be done, in said city, to wit:

To widen ~~High~~ Avenue in said city from the East line Orange street to the west line of _____ street, in said city.

2nd. That the land which is by this board deemed necessary to be taken therefor, and which this board intends to take therefor, is described as follows, to wit:-

All that certain land situated, lying and being in said city, and particularly described as follows:-

3rd: That the exterior boundaries of the district hereby established, and the exterior boundaries of the district of lands hereby declared to be affected and benefitted by said work or improvement, and to be assessed to pay the damages, costs and expenses thereof, are described as follows, to wit:-

4th:- The Redlands Daily Facts, a daily newspaper published and circulated in said city, is hereby designated as the newspaper in which the street superintendent of said city shall cause to be published, in the manner and form required by law, notice of the passage of this resolution and the said street superintendent is hereby directed to cause notices of

NOTICE OF PUBLIC WORK.

(Widening High Avenue)

Notice is hereby given, that on November 5th, 1902, the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, California, did, at its meeting on said day, pass a resolution, numbered 202, declaring its intention to order the following street work to be done, to-wit:

To widen High Avenue in said city from the east line of Orange street to a point north of the center line of Fifth street, in said city.

That the land which was by said Board deemed to be and by its said resolution was declared to be necessary to be taken for said work and improvement, is described as follows, to-wit:

All that certain land situated, lying and being in said city, and particularly described as follows: Beginning at the northeast corner of High Avenue and Orange street (as now established upon the ground), thence north ten feet; thence east 110 feet to an alley; thence south 10 feet; thence west to the place of beginning.

Also beginning at the southwest corner of lot 17 of Block B, Link Addition to the City of Redlands; thence east 170 feet to the southeast corner of lot 17 of said block B; thence north 10 feet; thence west 170 feet to an alley; thence south 10 feet to the place of beginning.

That the exterior boundaries of the district of land established and declared by said resolution to be affected and benefited by said work, or improvement, and to be assessed to pay the damages, costs and expenses thereof, are described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the northeast corner of High Avenue and Orange street (as now established upon the ground), thence east 295 feet to the southeast corner of Lot 17 of Block B of Link Addition to the City of Redlands; thence north to the northeast corner of said Lot 17; thence west along the north boundary line of said Lot 17 and Lots 18 and 19 of said block B, to the northwest corner of said Lot 19; thence south along the west boundary line of said Lot 19 to a point immediately opposite the northeast corner of Lot 2 of said block B; thence west to northwest corner of said Lot 2; thence south to the place of beginning.

Reference is hereby made to said resolution of intention No. 202, for further particulars.
