

NOTICE OF AWARD OF CONTRACT

Pursuant to the resolution of award of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, adopted on the 1st day of February, 1922, directing this notice, Notice is hereby given that the said Board of Trustees, in open session, on said date, opened, examined and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the following street work, to-wit:

That seven ornamental lighting posts be constructed and erected upon the west side of Alvarado street in said city, between Cypress Avenue and Palm Avenue therein, and three ornamental lighting posts be constructed and erected on the east side of said Alvarado street between said Cypress Avenue and a point 660 feet south of the south line of said Cypress Avenue, together with wire, pipes, conduits, lamps and all other suitable and necessary appliances for the purpose of lighting said street.

All said posts to be located and erected at the place shown upon the plans for said work and all of said work and all materials therefor, including such posts to be in accordance with, and as required by, and as shown upon such plans and the specifications therefor prepared by the City Engineer of said city for such work, and both of which plans and specifications are on file in the office of the said city Engineer to which reference is hereby made for all particulars and details concerning said work and improvement.

Said board of trustees does hereby declare and determine that said proposed work and improvement is of more than local or ordinary public benefit and affects and benefits the land and district hereinafter described, which said district is hereby declared to be the district benefited by said work, and improvement; and that therefore the entire cost and expenses of said work and improvement is hereby made chargeable against, and shall be assessed upon said land and district hereinafter described; that the exterior boundaries of said district established and the exterior boundaries of the land hereby declared to be benefitted by said work and improvement and to be assessed to pay the cost and expenses thereof and to be known as the assessment district, are described as follows:

Said district is situated within the said City of Redlands, San Bernardino County, California, and described as follows:

Beginning at the northwesterly corner of lot three of Alvarado Terrace Addition No. 3; thence to the north-easterly corner of said lot 3; thence along the easterly line of said lot 3 to lot 4 of said Addition; thence to the northeasterly corner of said lot 4; thence to the southeasterly corner of said Addition; thence westerly to the southwesterly corner of said Addition; thence along the easterly line of Alvarado street to Palm Avenue; thence along the northerly line of Palm Avenue to a point 195 feet from the westerly line of said Alvarado street; thence northerly and parallel with the westerly line of Alvarado street to Cypress Avenue; thence along the southerly line of Cypress Avenue to the point of beginning, excepting therefrom any public street contained therein. Said Alvarado Terrace Addition being according to a map thereof of record in the office of the county recorder of said county.

It is hereby determined, in pursuance of an Act of the Legislature of the State of California, known as Improvement Act of 1911, that serial bonds shall be issued to represent assessments of \$25.00 or over for the cost of said work and improvement.

Said bonds shall be serial extending over a period of nine years from the second day of January next succeeding their date, and an even annual proportion of the principal sum thereof shall be payable by coupon on the second day of January of each year after their date until the whole is paid, and the interest shall be payable semi-annually by coupons on the second days of January and July, respectively of each year, at the rate of seven per cent per annum on all sums unpaid until the whole of said principal and interest are paid. Said

bonds shall be issued in form and a required, by law.

And thereafter, to-wit, on the 1st day of February, 1922, awarded the contract for said work to the lowest regular responsible bidder, to-wit Southwest Electrical Company at the prices named for said work in his proposal on file, to-wit: \$799.85 for a set of said work complete.
