

Ornamental Lights - West Fern Ave.

NOTICE OF AWARD OF CONTRACT

No. 358

(Ornamental Lights—West Fern Ave.)

Pursuant to the resolution of award of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, adopted on the 2nd day of January, 1924, directing this notice, notice is hereby given that the said Board of Trustees, in open session, on said date, opened, examined and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the following street work, to-wit:

That twenty-two ornamental lighting posts be constructed and erected upon West Fern Avenue in said city between Center street and Cajon street, all as indicated and shown upon plans therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city to which reference is hereby made, together with wire, pipe, conduit, lamps and all other suitable and necessary appliances for the purpose of lighting said street between said points.

All of said posts are to be located and erected at the places shown upon the plans therefor and all of said work and the materials therefor, including such posts to be in accordance with and as required by and as shown upon such plans for said work, and the specifications therefor prepared by said City Engineer for such work, which plans and specifications are on file in said engineer's office to which reference is hereby made for all particulars and details concerning such work or improvement upon said avenue.

Said contemplated work or improvement is, in the opinion of said board, of more than local or ordinary public benefit, and the expense of said work or improvement upon said avenue where said work or improvement is to be done is hereby made chargeable upon the district herein after specified, that the exterior boundaries of said district hereby established and the exterior boundaries of the lands hereby declared to be benefitted by said work or improvement upon such avenue and to be assessed to pay the costs and expenses thereof, are indicated and shown by a brown boundary line showing and indicating the exterior boundaries and extent of the territory included in such district, upon a plat or map showing the lands embraced within such district, and marked "Plans" (being the plans for such work aforesaid) and being now on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city, to which map reference is hereby made.

The lands embraced within such brown boundary lines, except streets and alleys shown therein, constitute the district declared benefitted by such work or improvement and to be assessed to pay the costs and expenses thereof.

Said board also determines and declares that serial bonds shall be issued to represent each assessment for \$25.00 or more, remaining unpaid for twenty days after the date of the warrant as provided by law, to represent the expenses of said work or improvement. Said serial bonds shall extend over a period of nine years from the second day of January, next succeeding the 15th day of the next November following their date, and an even annual proportion of the principal sum thereof shall be payable by coupon on the second day of January, every year, after the 15th day of the next November following their date, until the whole is paid; and the interest shall be payable semi-annually by coupon, on the second days of January and July, respectively, of each year, at the rate of seven per cent per annum, on all sums unpaid, until the whole of said principal sum and interest are paid.

Said bonds shall be issued in the form and manner and as required by the Improvement Act of 1911, so-called.

And thereafter, to-wit, on the 2nd day of January, 1924, awarded the contract for said work to the lowest regular responsible bidder, to-wit: H. C. Young Electric Co., at the prices named for said work in his proposal on file, to-wit: \$1604.50, for all of said work.
