NOTICE OF AWARD OF CONTRACT

No. 355

(Ornamental Lights—East Fern Ave. and Alvarado St.)

Pursuant to statute and resolution of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, adopted on the 17th day of October, 1923, directing this notice, the undersigned invites and will receive at his office, in said City, up to two o'clock p. m. on the 7th day of November, 1923, sealed proposals or bids, for the following street work, to be done according to specifications therefor, posted and on file adopted for said work, as herein mentioned, to-wit:

1st. That fourteen ornamental lighting posts be constructed and erected upon East Fern Avenue, in said city, between the west side of Myrtle street (produced across said avenue) and the east side of Cajon street, all as shown and indicated upon plans therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city to which reference is hereby made, together with wire, pipe, conduit, lamps and all other suitable and necessary appliances for the purpose of lighting said street between said points.

2nd. That thirteen ornamental lighting posts be constructed and erected upon Alvarado street, in said city, between the northerly line of Cypress Avenue and the southerly line of West Fern Avenue, all as shown and indicated upon plans therefor on file in the office of said City Engineer, to which reference is hereby made, together with wire, pipe, conduits, lamps and all other suitable and necessary appliances for the purpose of lighting said street between said points.

3rd. That sixteen ornamental lighting posts be constructed and erected upon Alvarado street, in said city, between the northerly side of West Fern Avenue and the southerly side of West Olive Avenue, all as shown upon plans therefor on file in the office of said City Engineer to which reference is hereby made, together with wire, pipe, conduits, lamps and all other suitable and necessary appliances for the purpose of lighting said street between said points.

All of said posts mentioned in each of said 1st, 2nd and 3rd paragraphs above to be located and erected at the places shown upon the respective plans therefor and all of said work and the materials therefor, including such posts to be in accordance with and as required by, and as shown upon such respective plans for said work, and the specifications therefor prepared by said City Engineer for such respective work, which plans and specifications are on file in said engineer's office to which reference is hereby made for all particulars and details concerning such work or improvement upon each of said streets and avenues.

Said contemplated work or improvement mentioned in said paragraphs 1st, 2nd and 3rd above, is, in the opinion of said board, as to each of said streets and avenues, of more than local or ordinary public benefit, and the expense of said work or improvement upon each of said streets and avenues where said work or improvement is to be done is hereby made chargeable upon the district hereinafter specified, that the exterior boundaries of each of said districts hereby established and the exterior boundaries of the lands hereby declared to be benefitted by said work or improvement upon each such street or avenue and to be assessed to pay the costs and expenses thereof, are each indicated and shown by a brown boundary line showing and indicating the exterior boundaries and extent of the territory included in each such respective district, upon a plat or map showing the lands embraced within such respective district, and marked "Plans" (being the plans for each such respective item of work aforesaid) and being now on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city, to which map reference is hereby made.

The lands embraced within such brown boundary lines, except streets and alleys shown therein, constitute the district declared benefitted by such work or improvement and to be assessed to pay the costs and expenses thereof for each respective district.

Each of said four items of work shall constitute a separate item of work for which separate bids shall be made therefor.

Said board also determines and declares that serial bonds shall be issued to represent each assessment for \$25.00 or more, remaining unpaid for twenty days after the date of the warrant as provided by law, to represent the expenses of said work or improvement in each of said four items of work. Said serial bonds shall extend over a period of nine years from the second day of January, next succeeding the 15th day of the next November following their date, and an even annual proportion of the principal sum thereof shall be payable by coupon on the second day of January, every year, after the 15th day of the next November following their date, until the whole is paid; and the interest shall be payable semi-annually by coupon, on the second days of January and July, respectively, of each year, at the rate of seven per cent per annum, on all sums unpaid, until the whole of said principal sum and interest are paid.

Said bonds shall be issued in the form and manner and as required by law.

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION

(East Fern Ave. and Alvarado St., Ornamental Lights, and Sixth St., Sidewalks.)

Resolved, That the public interest and convenience require, and that it is the intention of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands to order the following street work to be done, and improvement to be made, to-wit:

1st. That fourteen ornamental lighting posts be constructed and erected upon East Fern Avenue, in said city, between the west side of Myrtle street (produced across said avenue) and the east side of Cajon street, all as shown and indicated upon plans therefor on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city to which reference is hereby made, together with wire, pipe, conduit, lamps and all other suitable and necessary appliances for the purpose of lighting said street between said points.

2nd. That thirteen ornamental lighting posts be constructed and erected upon Alvarado street, in said city, between the northerly line of Cypress Avenue and the southerly line of West Fern Avenue, all as shown and indicated upon plans therefor on file in the office of said City Engineer, to which reference is hereby made, together with wire, pipe, conduits, lamps and all other suitable and necessary appliances for the purpose of lighting said street between said points.

All of said work shall be done in accordance with plans, specifications, profiles and cross-sections therefor adopted for doing said work and now on file in the office of said City Engineer, to which reference is hereby made.
