

## Ornamental Light

## NOTICE OF AWARD OF CONTRACT

No. 342  
(Ornamental Lights West State and  
Kendall Sts.)

Pursuant to the resolution of award of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, adopted on the 6th day of December, 1922, directing this notice, notice is hereby given that the said Board of Trustees, in open session, on said date, opened, examined and publicly declared all sealed proposals or bids offered for the following street work, to-wit:

First:—That nine ornamental lighting posts be constructed and erected upon West State street in said city between the east side of First street and the west side of Third street, all as shown and indicated upon plans therefore on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city, to which plans reference is hereby made, together with wire, pipe, conduits, lamps and all other suitable and necessary appliances for the purpose of lighting said streets between said points.

Second: — That ten ornamental lighting posts be constructed and erected upon Kendall street in said city between the south side of Sacramento street and the north side of Brookside Avenue, all as shown and indicated upon plans therefor on file in said engineer's office to which reference is hereby made, together with wire, pipe, conduits, lamps and all other suitable and necessary appliances for the purpose of lighting said street between said points.

All of said posts mentioned in each of said paragraphs "First" and "Second" to be located and erected at the places shown upon the said respective plans therefor and all of said work and all materials therefor, including such posts to be in accordance with, and as required by, and as shown upon such respective plans for said work, and the specifications therefor prepared by said City Engineer for such respective work, which plans and specifications are on file in said engineer's office to which reference is hereby made for all particulars and details concerning such work and improvement upon each of said streets.

Said contemplated work and improvement, in the opinion of said board, is, as to each of said streets, of more than local or ordinary public benefit, and the expense of such work and improvement upon each of said streets is hereby made chargeable upon the respective district hereinafter specified; that the exterior boundaries of each of such districts hereby established and the exterior boundaries of the lands hereby declared to be benefitted by such work and improvement upon each of said streets and to be assessed to pay the cost and expenses of said work and improvement upon each such street are described as follows:

(a) As to the work and improvement described in paragraph "First" above mentioned, said district and lands benefitted are described as follows: Beginning at the northeast corner of lot one in block 3 of the Town Plat of Redlands; thence south to the southeast corner of lot 12, block 4 of said Town Plat; thence west to the southwest corner of lot 6 of block one of said Town Plat; thence north to the northwest corner of lot 7 of block 2 of said plat; thence east to the place of beginning.

(b) As to the work and improvement described in said paragraph "Second" above mentioned, said district and lands benefitted are described as follows: Beginning at a point fifty feet easterly from the southwesterly corner of lot 3 of Peller's subdivision No. 2 in said city; thence to a point on the south line of lot 13 of Lord's subdivision in said city 50 feet northeasterly of the east line of Kendall street; thence to the southeast corner of said lot 13; thence to the southeast corner of lot 17 of said Lord subdivision; thence to the northeast corner of lot 13 of said Lord subdivision; thence to the northwest corner of lot 4 of said Lord Subdivision; thence to the southwest corner of lot 6 of said subdivision; thence to the southwest corner of lot 8 of said subdivision; thence to a point on the southerly line of lot 12 fifty feet westerly from Kendall street; thence south and parallel with the west line of said Kendall street to Brookside Avenue; thence east to the place of beginning.

And thereafter, to-wit, on the 6th day of December, 1922, awarded the contract for said work to the lowest regular responsible bidder, to-wit: The Southwest Electric Company at the prices named for said work in his proposal on file, to-wit: \$697.00 for work on West State Street and \$639.00 for said work on Kendall Street for all of said work as described above.

# Resolution of Intention

## No. 342

Resolved, that the public interest and convenience require, and that it is the intention of the Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands to order the following street work to be done and improvements made, to-wit:

First:—That nine ornamental lighting posts be constructed and erected upon West State street in said city between the east side of First street and the west side of Third street, all as shown and indicated upon plans therefore on file in the office of the City Engineer of said city, to which plans reference is hereby made, together with wire, pipe, conduits, lamps and all other suitable and necessary appliances for the purpose of lighting said streets between said points.

Second: — That ten ornamental lighting posts be constructed and erected upon Kendall street in said city between the south side of Sacramento street and the north side of Brookside Avenue, all as shown and indicated upon plans therefor on file in said engineer's office to which reference is hereby made, together with wire, pipe, conduits, lamps and all other suitable and necessary appliances for the purpose of lighting said street between said points.

All of said posts mentioned in each of said paragraphs "First" and "Second" to be located and erected at the places shown upon the said respective plans therefor and all of said work and all materials therefor, including such posts to be in accordance with, and as required by, and as shown upon such respective plans for said work, and the specifications therefor prepared by said City Engineer for such respective work, which plans and specifications are on file in said engineer's office to which reference is hereby made for all particulars and details concerning such work and improvement upon each of said streets.

(a) As to the work and improvement described in paragraph "First" above mentioned, said district and lands benefitted are described as follows: Beginning at the northeast corner of lot one in block 3 of the Town Plat of Redlands; thence south to the southeast corner of lot 12, block 4 of said Town Plat; thence west to the southwest corner of lot 6 of block one of said Town Plat; thence north to the northwest corner of lot 7 of block 2 of said plat; thence east to the place of beginning.

(b) As to the work and improvement described in said paragraph "Second" above mentioned, said district and lands benefitted are described as follows: Beginning at a point fifty feet easterly from the southwesterly corner of lot 3 of Peller's subdivision No. 2 in said city; thence to a point on the south line of lot 13 of Lord's subdivision in said city 50 feet northeasterly of the east line of Kendall street; thence to the southeast corner of said lot 13; thence to the southeast corner of lot 17 of said Lord subdivision; thence to the northeast corner of lot 13 of said Lord subdivision; thence to the northwest corner of lot 4 of said Lord Subdivision; thence to the southwest corner of lot 6 of said subdivision; thence to the southwest corner of lot 8 of said subdivision; thence to a point on the southerly line of lot 12 fifty feet westerly from Kendall street; thence south and parallel with the west line of said Kendall street to Brookside Avenue; thence east to the place of beginning.

Notice is hereby given that on the 15th day of November, 1922, at 2 o'clock p. m., in the Council Chamber of said Board, any and all persons having any objections to the proposed work or improvement, may appear before said Board, and show cause why said work or improvement should not be carried out in accordance with this resolution.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this resolution twice in the manner required by law, in the Redlands Daily Facts, a daily newspaper published and circulated in said city, hereby designated for that purpose.

The Superintendent of Streets of said city is hereby directed to post notice of the passage of this resolution in the time, manner and as required by law.
