RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO VACATE A PORTION OF A CERTAIN STREET IN THE CITY OF REDLANDS Street Vacation No. 38 -

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The City Council of the City of Redlands hereby elects to proceed under the provisions of Division 9, Part 3, Chapter 2 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California and to vacate a portion of a street in the manner provided therein.

SECTION TWO: The City Council does hereby declare its intention to order the vacation of a certain street described as follows:

All that portion of 60 foot wide Sunset Street between Summit Avenue and Campbell Avenue as shown on Map No. 2 of a Portion of Redlands Heights recorded in Book 6, page 36 of Maps, San Bernardino County, State of California

SECTION THREE: The City Council hereby determines that the vacation of the certain street described herein is required by public interest, convenience, safety and welfare.

SECTION FOUR: A map setting the particulars of the proposed street vacation shall be on file in the office of the Department of Public Works and available for inspection by persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation.

SECTION FIVE: The City Council hereby fixes the time and date and place of Public Hearing on the above described street closing at 7:00 P.M. on the 16th day of July, 1963 in the regular meeting place of the City Council, Redlands, California.

SECTION SIX: Within fifteen days after its passage, this resolution shall be published in the Redlands Daily Facts, a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in the City of Redlands, California.
