

RESOLUTION NO. 3155

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO VACATE PORTIONS
OF A CERTAIN STREET IN THE CITY OF REDLANDS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The City Council of the City of Redlands hereby elects to proceed under the provisions of Division 9, Part 3, Chapter 2, of the Street and Highways Code of the State of California and to vacate portions of streets in the manner provided therein.

SECTION TWO: The City Council does hereby declare its intention to order the vacation of portions of a certain street described as follows:

Legal Description for Vacation of that portion of Toyon Avenue as shown on Golden West Addition Tract No. 1934 as recorded in Book 28 of Maps, Page 3, and all of Toyon Avenue as shown on Abbot Subdivision Tract No. 1985 as recorded in Book 28 of Maps, Page 66 in the Office of the County Recorder, County of San Bernardino, State of California described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the Northeast right-of-way line of Ash Street (50 feet wide) with the Northwest right-of-way line of Toyon Avenue (30 feet wide); thence Northeasterly along said Northwest right-of-way line of Toyon Avenue to its intersection with the Southwest right-of-way line of Bond Street (60 feet wide); thence Southeasterly along the Southeasterly prolongation of said Southwest right-of-way line of Bond Street to its intersection with the Southeast right-of-way line of said Toyon Avenue; thence Southwesterly along said Southeast right-of-way line of Toyon Avenue to its intersection with the Southeasterly prolongation of said Northeast right-of-way line of Ash Street; thence Northwest-erly along said Southeasterly prolongation of the Northeast right-of-way line of Ash Street to the Point of Beginning.

SECTION THREE: The City Council hereby determines that the vacation of the portions of the certain street described herein is required by public interest, convenience, safety and welfare.

SECTION FOUR: A map setting the particulars of the proposed street vacation shall be on file in the office of the Department of Public Works and available for inspection by persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation.

SECTION FIVE: The City Council hereby fixes the time and date and place of Public Hearing on the above-described street closing at 7:00 P.M. on the 21st day of January, 1975 in the regular meeting place of the City Council, Redlands, California.

SECTION SIX: Within fifteen days after its passage, this resolution shall be published in the Redlands Daily Facts, a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in the City of Redlands, California.
