

RESOLUTION NO. 2368

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO VACATE A PORTION OF A CERTAIN
STREET IN THE CITY OF REDLANDS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The City Council of the City of Redlands hereby elects to proceed under the provisions of Division 9, Part 3, Chapter 2 of the Street and Highways Code of the State of California and to vacate a portion of a street in the manner provided therein.

SECTION TWO: The City Council does hereby declare its intention to order the vacation of a portion of a certain street described as follows:

Beginning at the most Westerly corner of Lot 37, Tract No. 6047, Fern Grove, in the City of Redlands, County of San Bernardino, State of California, as per plat recorded in Book 76 of Maps, page 70, records of said County, said corner lies on a line which is parallel with and 32 feet Southeasterly of the center line of Fern Avenue; thence along the Southwesterly line of said Lot 37, South $27^{\circ}19'26''$ East 18.12 feet to a point on the Southeasterly right of way line of 100 foot wide Fern Avenue; thence along said line, South $56^{\circ}19'$ West 435.00 feet; thence North $33^{\circ}41'$ West 18.00 feet; thence along a line which is parallel with and 32 feet Southeasterly of said center line of Fern Avenue, North $56^{\circ}19'$ East 437.01 feet to the point of beginning.

SECTION THREE: The City Council hereby determines that the vacation of the certain street described herein is required by public interest, convenience, safety and welfare.

SECTION FOUR: A map setting the particulars of the proposed street vacation shall be on file in the office of the Department of Public Works and available for inspection by persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation.

SECTION FIVE: The City Council hereby fixes the time and date and place of Public Hearing on the above described street closing at 7:00 P.M. on the fifth day of May, 1964 in the regular meeting place of the City Council, Redlands, California.

SECTION SIX: Within fifteen days after its passage, this resolution shall be published in the Redlands Daily Facts, a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in the City of Redlands, California.
